INSTRUCTIONS FOR COACHES, PARENTS AND SPECTATORS:

Register at Office for a guest pass to use the pool facilities and snack bar (some restrictions may apply)

Park Cars and Trailers in designated parking areas

Boat ramps will be available for launching and recovering. For safety no launching during fleet launch and recovery.

All Coach Boats shall register with RC and display CBYRA flags

Coach, Support and Spectator boats should check with Harbor Master

for overnight parking spot.

Awards will be given for top three Opti finishers OPTI Championship and Green Fleets, Laser Radial, and c420 and i420 Classes. Overall Opti will also receive awards.
