

2020 HYC Reggae Regatta

August 22, 2020 The Houston Yacht Club Shoreacres, Texas

NOTICE OF RACE

1. RULES

- 1.1 The regatta will be governed by the rules as defined in *The Racing Rules of Sailing*.
- 1.2 All Center for Disease Control (CDC) and state guidelines in effect will be strictly followed.

2. ELIGIBILITY AND REGISTRATION

2.1 The regatta is open to all keel boats, dinghies, and multihulls. All keel boats and multihulls will race pursuit course(s). Dinghies will race on a buoy course.



- 2.2 A minimum of three yachts of the same design will constitute a class.
- 2.3 A class of fewer than the required number of entries will be regarded as having failed to form and may be assigned to another class, or an entry fee refund may be requested. Potential classes may be J/22, J/24, J/105, J/109, Ensign, Pursuit Spinnaker and Pursuit Non-Spinnaker, Pursuit TOMA, Pursuit Yardstick and One Design Distance Course (with a Rule 26 start).
- 2.4 Boats may enter at <u>www.regattanetwork.com</u> using the on-line entry form. The HYC website under Racing/Race Schedule also includes a registration link to regatta network. Only online entries will be accepted.
- 2.5 Entrants who do not find their desired class listed on the Regatta Network on-line entry form are invited to register as "Generic One-Design". Please contact the HYC Race and Regatta Chair (terry.eukel@hycraceandregatta.com) to receive a class assignment after the fact.

3. FEES

3.1	Entry Fee Multi-crew	\$60

3.5 Refunds on or before August 19 will be 90% of entry fee paid. No refunds after August 19.

4. SCHEDULE

- 4.1 Friday, 21 August 2020
 - **7:00 p.m.** Pursuit Line Competitors' briefing via online meeting.

4.2 Saturday, 22 August 2020

Pursuit Line

- **11:00 a.m.** Registration closes. Preparatory/Warning Signal for the handicap Pursuit Line (lower bay). The Pursuit line may have two races, weather permitting.
- 1:00 p.m. Warning signal for One Design Distance course (upper Bay).
- **1:30 p.m.** Preparatory/Warning Signal for handicap Pursuit Line (upper bay). This is the second of two races, weather permitting.

Dinghy Line

- **10:00 a.m.** Registration closes. Competitor's Briefing at the Beachcomber if current social distancing guidelines allow. If no competitor's briefing is possible, we will make ourselves available for specific questions on an individual basis.
- **11:00 a.m.** Preparatory/Warning Signal for the Dinghy Line. The Dinghy line may have multiple races, weather permitting.
- After races, all racers are invited to HYC where there will be a keg in the Porthole. Reggae plate dinners are available for purchase.
- Awards Ceremony approximately 2 hours after the last Race Committee Boat enters the harbor. In the event of a protest, the class(es) of the protesting party(s) may receive awards after the protest hearing. Results for the fleet may not wait for the protest results.

5. MEASUREMENTS

5.1 Yachts racing PHRF MUST have a 2020 PHRF rating certificate. Yachts racing ORC Spinnaker must have a valid 2020 ORC rating. Yachts racing TOMA must have a valid 2020 TOMA certificate. Yachts racing Portsmouth Yardstick must have a valid 2020 North American Portsmouth Yardstick certificate. Yachts racing One Design will comply with all requirements of the relevant class association.

6. SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

6.1 The Sailing Instructions will be posted on www.regattanetwork.com by August 20 at 7:00 p.m. The Sailing Instructions will also be posted on the official notice board "HYC Race Information" located in the breezeway adjacent to the HYC Office.

7. VENUE

7.1 All races will be sailed in that part of Galveston Bay bounded by Morgan's Point on the North, the San Leon Shoreline on the south, the Houston Ship Channel on the East, and the La Porte/Shoreacres shoreline. Pursuit racing will start near Clear Creek Channel Marker #2. The afternoon pursuit race will be north of the Bayport Ship Channel and end near HYC.

8. THE COURSES

8.1 The courses will be detailed at the Competitors' Briefing. Courses planned are distance races with pursuit starts. A dinghy line is planned for Optis, Sunfish, Lasers in the upper bay only.

9. SCORING

- 9.1 A single race is required to be completed to constitute a series.
- 9.2 The low-point scoring system of RRS Appendix A will apply.

10. BERTHING

- 10.1 Racers are encouraged to leave their boats at HYC for the week before and week after the regatta at no charge. HOWEVER, upon arrival all boat owners must complete a registration form available at the front desk and include an emergency contact number.
- 10.2 Hotel rooms are also available in the clubhouse with a reservation. Please check with the club staff for availability and rates.

11. PRIZES

11.1 Trophies will be awarded based on the number of registrants per class at the end of early registration. Additional trophies may be awarded if more entries enter a class after early registration.

12. DISCLAIMER OF LIABILITY

12.1 Competitors participate in the regatta entirely at their own risk. See Rule 4, Decision to Race. The organizing authority will not accept any liability for material damage or personal injury, or death sustained in conjunction with or prior to, during, or after the regatta.

13. HEALTH AND SAFETY - COVID-19 PRECAUTIONS

- 13.1 See section 3.4 for cancellation policy.
- 13.2 Distancing and disinfecting measures will be in place, including but not limited to: - Any CDC guidelines in effect will be strictly followed.
 - Wearing gaiters or masks indoors is required and recommended outside.
 - Bring hand sanitizer for use on shore and on the water.
 - Open air briefings with maximum distance between teams.
 - Call-in briefings and protest hearings.
 - Outdoor social arrangements.
