Eligibility: The regatta is open to any classes providing at least three entries. Classes requesting a start should email Triton499@gmail.com by Sunday 20 September 2020.

Rules: The regatta will be governed by the Racing Rules of Sailing 2017-2020 and the CBYRA 2020 General Sailing Instructions found at: http://www.cbyra.org/application/files/1515/8427/4100/2020_Green_Book.pdf.

Rendezvous: **At 0930 in vicinity of "77" FI G 2.5s (approximately 2 nm south of Cove Point).**

Radio: Boats should monitor VHF 71 for courtesy communications from the Race Committee.

Start: Between yellow or orange flag on Race Committee boat and "77" FI G 2.5s or nearby inflatable mark.

The first warning signal is scheduled for 1000. The planned starting sequence is:

1005	Start	Multihull A and B
1010	Start	PHRF A and CRCA

* Yachts in classes having few entries will be combined for additional awards. All yachts will be competing for at least one award

** Class flags used by Race Committee:

Multihull A and B- W flag for both (this changes CBYRA Greenbook 7.1)

PHRF A - #9 flag

CRCA - White streamer

Signals: RRS 26 "Starting Races".

Course: The Cove Point LNG Terminal, including its Safety Zone perimeter, must be left to port.

Finish: Between yellow or orange flag on Race Committee boat and West River G"1" FL G 4s. Course is 30.6 nm.

Time Limit: 1900 for all classes. Boats not finishing within two hours of the first boat in their class to finish

will be scored TLE and awarded points equal to the number of finishers plus two, but in no case more than the number of starters. This changes RRS 35 and A4.1.

Scoring: CRCA handicap ratings will be determined in coordination with CRCA representative.

Protests: Mail to SSC Race Committee, at address above, postmarked no later than Monday 28 September 2020. Hearing at a time and place to be announced.

Awards: 1st/3, 2nd/5, 3rd/7 & 4th/10+ starters. Additional awards may be given at the discretion of the Race Committee.
