## **Regatta Schedule**

- Competitor's Meeting Aug 4 5:00 pm via ZOOM online meeting.
- Entries must be registered online by Aug 4 at 10:00 pm Eastern Time
- Arrival at RHYC 8:30-9:30 am
- Launch and sail out ASAP
- 1<sup>st</sup> warning signal on the water 10:25 am
- We will take a short lunch break on the water
  - BRING LUNCH / SNACKS / WATER
- No race will start after 4:30 pm
- Results will be posted on the event website as soon as scoring can be completed.
- Awards will be mailed to the winners /club after the regatta



### Site Notes 2020

- Please stay with your teams and observe CDC recommended social distancing and personal protection guidelines while onsite.
- Please rig and de-rig with your team.
- Please stagger launch and retrieval of your boat using all physical distancing guidelines.
- The RHYC Clubhouse, restaurant, and pool are closed to non-members during this event.
- Port-a-pot and handwashing station at the Beach
- Current state & local requirements for protection against the transmission of COVID-19 must be practiced throughout the regatta and on the RHYC site
  - Nose and mouth covering masks must be worn on land
  - No masks worn on the water
  - Wash your hands with soap and water at our handwashing station at the beach
  - Wash any equipment that is shared with soap and water at our boat washing station near the beach.

### SI

- Competitors and Coaches must wear USCG approved PFDs while afloat
- Race communications will be on VHF Channel 69
- Competitors must check-in at the signal boat before the first race starts
- The 3 minute Audible Signal starting sequence will be used
- The course and any changes to SIs will be announced by the signal boat
- C420s will be started first, then Laser Radials



Course

- Race area is in the Chester River at the mouth of the Langford Creek
- Windward and Leward marks will be inflatable cylinders
- Start/Finish Pin will be orange sphere
- Starting line will be between blue flag staff on R/C signal boat and starting pin
- Finish line will be between blue flag staff on Finish boat and finish pin
- Start / Finish Line is CLOSED
- Individual recalls will be in accordance with RRS 29.1



# Scoring & Protests

- The Race will be scored per RRS Appendix A4, Low Point System
- One race constitutes a regatta.
- If 6 or more races are sailed, each boat's worst score will be discarded.
- There is no Protest Committee.
- To resolve an infraction, a boat must perform a 360 degree turn.
