

1 Rule

1.1 The Regatta will be governed by the rules as defined in *The Racing Rules of Sailing*.

2 Eligibility and Entry

- 2.1 All boats are invited to participate in the Regatta. The Regatta will be a pursuit race with starting times assigned corresponding with the boat's PHRF rating.
- 2.2 It is the responsibility of the skipper to comply with current official COVID-19 regulations in effect on the day of the Regatta.
- 2.3 Skippers may enter the yacht by completing the online entry form on Regatta Network available at scyc.org/racing. Only on-line entries will be accepted.
- 2.4 Skippers shall provide the boat's PHRF rating on the entry form. If no current rating is available, a suitable PHRF rating will be provided by the organizing authority.
- 2.5 **Regatta Network will be employed for the registration of only the yacht entry.** To complete the registration, please access the registration of skipper at the BBBS web site available at: https://e-activist.com/page/62000/event/1

Registration of skipper on the BBBS web site is required to complete the registration.

3 Fees

- 3.1 The yacht entry fee only is \$10.00 due by midnight on Wednesday September 2. Entry fees submitted after this deadline shall be \$20.00. There is an additional registration fee according to 3.4 below.
- 3.2 Yacht entry fees must be paid by credit card or PayPal on Regatta Network.
- 3.3 Yacht entry fees are non-refundable
- 3.4 Skipper and crew registration shall be completed on the BBBS web site. Fees for registration shall be as follows:

4 Schedule

- 4.1 There will be no in-person competitors' meeting. A ZOOM virtual meeting will be held on Saturday, September 5th at 8:00 PM. An invitation to join the meeting will be emailed to each completed entry.
- 4.2 The scheduled time of the warning signal is 1255 hours on the race day.
- 4.4 There will be one race around fixed marks for this Regatta. Starting times for each boat will be included in the Sailing Instructions.
- 4.5 Race results will be posted on Regatta Network and on the bulletin board at the Regatta Shed following the race.

5 Sailing Instructions

- 5.1 The sailing instructions will be posted on-line prior to midnight on September 2nd. No printed copies will be made available from the Race Committee prior to racing.
- 5.2 A course diagram and location of marks will be provided in the sailing instructions.

6 Venue


Racing will be around fixed marks within a three-mile radius of the Walton Lighthouse on the Santa Cruz Small Craft Harbor west jetty.

8 Scoring

- 8.1 For this pursuit race, the order of finish shall determine the standing of each boat.
- 8.2 Divisions will be established for spinnaker, jib and main, and multi-hull entries.
