ORGANIZING AUTHORITY:

The regatta is organized under the authority of the Bay-Waveland Yacht Club and will be sailed under management of its Race Committee.

RULES:

The regatta will be governed by the *Rules* as defined in the current "Racing Rules of Sailing", the prescriptions of US Sailing; appropriate and respective Class Sailing Association rules; except as any of these are altered by the Sailing Instructions, the Sailing Instructions which shall govern in event of any conflict. This event is open to all sailors.

Due to COVID concerns, we request all participants respect current governmental guidelines and to practice social distancing.

RRS 4: The responsibility for a boat's decision to participate in a race or to continue racing is hers alone.

CLASSES & FEES:

Viper, VX1 & Flying Scot - \$20.00

3 boats of the same design will comprise a class. Viper & VX1 will start together.

Six races will be attempted. One completed race in a class constitutes a series for each class.

SAILING INSTRUCTIONS:

Sailing Instructions will be available at the Registration Desk at Bay-Waveland Yacht Club.

TROPHIES:

1st, 2nd, and 3rd Overall Place in each Class will be awarded based on the number of boats registered.

SCORING:

A modified Low-Point Scoring System, Rule A2 will apply except that no race score will be excluded from a competitor's series score. Ties will be broken as provided in Rule A8.

RACING AREA:

The racing area will be in the Bay of St. Louis, generally east of the Bay-Waveland Yacht Club.
