

Notice of Race 2020 Moore 24 National Championship August 21-23, 2020

INVITATION: Richmond Yacht Club and Moore 24 One Design Association invite you to the 2020 Moore 24 National Championship on San Francisco Bay

1 Rules

- 1.1 The regatta will be governed by the Racing Rules of Sailing, the Moore 24 Class Rules, this Notice of Race, and the Sailing Instructions.
- 1.2 Rule 40 is deleted and replaced by "Competitors are required to wear a PFD while on the water except during brief periods when changing clothing". Code Flag "Y" will not be displayed.

2 Entry and Eligibility

- 2.1 All Moore 24s in good standing with Moore 24 fleet are eligible for entry. Each sailor must sign a Waiver and Release of Liability. These forms will be available at check in and at weigh in.
- 2.2 All skippers must have paid 2020 class dues to participate.
- 2.3 Eligible boats may enter by registering and completing the online entry form at www.richmondyc.org

3 Fees

- 3.1 The regular non-refundable entry fee is \$145.00 and is applicable if entry is completed by 2000 hours on Thursday, Aug 20st 2020. A late fee of \$50 will apply to registration after Thursday, Aug 20st 2020. All entries are refundable if event canceled.
- 3.2 Registration Closes at 1800 on August 20th, 2020

4 Schedules

- 4.1 Competitors Weigh in will be conducted Thursday, August 20th at 1800 through 2000 and Friday, August 21th at 0800 though 1000 outside the Regatta Room at RYC.
- 4.2 A Competitors briefing is scheduled for 1000 hours on Friday, Aug 21, 2020 at the RYC Clubhouse.
- 4.3 The Scheduled first warning signal is 1155 hours on Friday, Aug 21, 2020
- 4.4 Seven (7) races are scheduled and five (5) races will constitute a regatta. One (1) discard after completion of five (5) races. This changes A2.

5 Sailing Instructions:

5.1 The Sailing Instructions will be available in the clubhouse and online at www.regattanetwork.com after 1800 hours on Thursday, August 20, 2020.

6 Venue

- 6.1 Racing will be around inflatable buoys and fixed buoys in the vicinity of Olympic Circle on SF Bay.
- 6.2 A distance race will be included and take place inside the bay.

- 7.1 **Parking:** Trailer and RV parking will be available in the RYC overflow lot immediately to the NW of RYC. Please contact the Harbor Master at 510.234.6959
- 7.2 **Launching, Mooring and Haul outs:** Two hoists capable of lifting a Moore 24 are available. Do not tie up at the dock below the hoists. Raft up in the basin. All yachts must remain in the water during the regatta. Yachts requiring haul out due to damage must receive approval from the Principal Race Officer (PRO) or Jury.
