QUICK FACTS AND HOW THIS EVENT MAY BE DIFFERENT

Detailed COVID requirements are provided in a separate document referred to as COVID-19 EVENT SAFETY. Please be familiar with them. NO PARKING WILL BE ALLOWED ALONG THE DRIVEWAY OR SIDEWALK. OVERFLOW PARKING SHOULD GO TO INDIAN RIVERSIDE PARK IMMEDIATELY SOUTH OF THE SAILING CENTER PROPERTY.

Competitors

- Upon arrival, unloading of boats may be done along the sidewalk then find a spot to rig your boat. Maintain social distancing, must wear a mask if near others.
- Check-in will be by PA System & in the yard. Know your sail number and your teammates' names and which fleet you intend to race in.
- Awards will be by PA system & in the yard. The coach will hand out awards.
- NO food or drink will be provided. Bring your own. Be prepared.
- The Official Notice board will be online at Regatta Network

Parents/ Spectators

- Gatherings are discouraged, hence spectating from the upper deck is discouraged
- Bring a lawn chair for outdoor spectating
- Be available if there are weather delays as sailors will be asked to return to their cars or to leave the property.
- The Official Notice board will be online at Regatta Network
- Spectators Boats should see the coach boat notice about the boat ramp closing.

Race Committee/Volunteers

- Saturday at 5 PM there will be a Race Committee meeting via ZOOM. Meeting login details will be emailed to you 24 hours in advance.
- PLEASE plan on this meeting and let Alan Jenkinson know in advance if you will be unable to participate by ZOOM.
- Boat captains for each committee/safety boat are asked to prepare their boats with starting horns, flags, marks, finish sheets, medical kits, (etc. as needed) either the day prior to the race or 10 AM Sunday morning before the crowd arrives.
- Bring your own lunch, beverages, and snacks for race day.
- Boat captains of privately owned Race Committee boats should communicate with their team where and when they would like to meet their team.

Coaches

- The Official Notice board will be online at Regatta Network
- There is no coach flag required for this event
- The Competitors & Coaches meeting will be via the PA System in the yard
- The JB Boat Ramp is currently closed. You MUST launch from an alternative site. You may launch at the Jensen Beach Causeway or the Stuart Causeway. If you wish to stow your trailer at the USSCMC you may do so after launching your boat or you may park at the bridge. Since the boat ramp is closed there is ample room to dock your boat at the boat ramp during this event.
- Coaches will be asked to collect the awards on the upper deck to distribute to their sailors. The award winners will be announced over the PA System, after all the awards winners are announced coaches will be asked to come to retrieve the awards for distribution to their winning sailors.
