Please let me know by Wednesday any sail changes / crew changes or cancellations you may have.

All spectator boats should be launched at the <u>Venice Train Depot boat ramp</u> – NOT at Higel Park. Trailers should also be parked in the Depot lot. Coach boats can be temporarily docked at the Higel Park transient dock, however, we ask spectators with personal boats to leave that space for support boats only.

Unlike in previous years, we are not able to close Higel Park to the public, so we need to keep traffic to a minimum. Lasers and C420s will still be able to rig and launch from Higel, but since we can't control the space, there is a possibility it will fill up Saturday morning with boaters / trailers. If that is the case, please have your Lasers / C420s find a rigging spot in the Venice Yacht Club parking lot. All Optis will rig in the Venice Yacht Club lot. We will have volunteers in both Higel and VYC to direct traffic. There will be limited parking in the Venice Yacht Club parking lot and overflow at the Venice South Jetty as well as in Graser Park.

Please stay tuned to the Regatta Network notice board for any news or changes in the day's schedule.

We look forward to a safe and fun event! As always, please observe safe distancing, try not to congregate in large groups and wear a buff or mask while working closely with others. VYC will be open to members and reciprocal members only, but please visit our many local restaurants and beaches! Light breakfast and on the water lunch will be provided for all sailors at registration.
