Date: Friday, August 28, 2020

Place: Mantoloking Yacht Club (south of Swan Point)

Check in on the race course by 9:30 am

Registration Fee: \$30 per boat (paid online only)

Includes registration and hat, to be handed out on-race course.

Additional hats are \$20 each.

As there will be no on-land events at MYC, all racers must check-in on the race course with designated patrol boats. First race is planned to start by 10am. We are planning on 3-4 races, finishing before lunchtime.

There will be no return to MYC and the awards will be announced online.

Qualifying:

- To qualify for the overall World Duckboat Championship, new duckboats must be plank on rib construction per the skantlings of the David Beaton drawings.
- Non-conforming boats (cold molded plywood or fiberglass construction boats) already built that have registered to sail in the World Duckboat Championship prior to Aug 28, 2010 will be grandfathered, but are restricted to junior sailors. Junior sailors wishing to compete for the overall World Duckboat Championship must sail a compliant plank on rib boat construction.
- The World Duckboat Championship Regatta Committee will endeavor to weigh several competitive boats in good condition at random to develop a minimum hull weight
