

## **Addendum 1 : NOR for FWC Championship at OSYC Sept 25-27 2020**

- 1) Padding on hulls: Any additional padding placed on the hulls, outside of the 4 positions on a stock Hobie Wave, will be allowed for this regatta only. Further discussion will be held at annual meeting with a vote of the class concerning this issue at the end of the season. This changes 5.1
- 2) Devices/Compass: Compasses are allowed that show a digital or analog heading, and or timing, and do not receive any type of Radio or GPS signal.

Not allowed would be any device, compass, phone, watch or otherwise, that performs any function or readout other than a boats heading and/or timing.

eg: does computations for the sailor such as lift, header or speed calculations.

It is suggested that anyone wanting to use a digital device/compass have an owner's manual available for class measurer upon request, per 5.4.

- 3) Bow NUMBERS: per 5.5 all boats shall display bow numbers on the outside of each hull. No letters, symbols, characters, figures etc. shall be used on the bow (NUMBERS only). Numbers should be dark in color and at least 12 inches tall. Make sure prior to registration that you contact the registrar to be sure your bow number is part of your membership record. Boats failing to display proper bow numbers will not be scored.
- 4) Sail Measurement: All sails shall be presented to the class measurer. Sails previously measured in the 2018 and 2019 season will be checked for verification marking and will Not need to be re-measured. All stock Hobie Wave sails will Not need to be measured but shall be presented. All other non-stock Hobie Wave sails that have not been previously measured as stated above shall be measured. Please bring them to the measurer with the top 3 battens removed.

\*If you have a letter of certification from your sailmaker, please bring it to show the measurer so that we can start to build a catalog of desired and certified Wave sailmakers.
