Rules:

- 1.1 The regatta will be governed by the *rules* as defined in the *Racing Rules of Sailing for 2017-2020*, except if any of these are changed by this Notice of Race or by the Sailing Instructions.
- 1.2 The US Sailing Prescriptions of Appendix U, Audible-Signal Racing System, will be in effect.
- 1.3 The US Sailing Prescriptions of Appendix V, Alternative Penalties, Rules V1 and V2 will be in effect.
- 1.4 Competitors are reminded to embody the Corinthian Spirit: 1. Regard the Racing Rules as agreements, the spirit and letter of which you should not evade or break. 2. Be humble in victory and gracious in defeat!
- 1.5 **Covid Restrictions and info:** The 2020 Board Bash Regatta is being held with several modifications due to the COVID-19 pandemic. This event is a great way to get back together and enjoy being on the water. However, we will follow the CDC, State of North Carolina, LNYC and local recommendations during this event such as social distancing, frequent hand washing and the use of a face mask especially when on land. The safety of our members, guests and staff are the driving force for the modifications to this annual event. There is a release that must be signed prior to competing in the regatta. Please note there will be NO onsite registrations. Our scoring and protest committees will be safely working remotely. Competitors will not need to check in onshore prior to this event, so please make sure that you register online with your correct sail number and email address. Please provide a phone number for text messages.

Three boats constitute a fleet. Three separate courses.

Laser Course: Laser Full, Laser Radial, Laser 4.7

Daggerboard Course: Vanguard V15, MC Scows & Sunfish

Junior: C420, O'Pen Skiff, Optimist Red, White, Blue

Sailing Instructions:

Sailing Instructions will be available online only at Regatta Network on or before Tuesday, September 22.

Scoring:

Scoring System will be the Low Point Scoring System of Appendix A.2 as hereby modified. Multiple races are scheduled; however, one completed race for all divisions will constitute a regatta. When fewer than 6 races have been completed, a boat's series score will be the total of her race scores. When 6 or more races have been completed, a boat's series score will be the total of her race scores excluding her worst score.

Awards:

Awards will be distributed after the event. Two man boats will receive two awards. Three boats minimum for a fleet. Given as follows:

- 3 boats = 1 award
- 4 to 6 boats = 2 awards
- 7 or more boats = 3 awards

Safety:

All competitors must wear PFD's at all times on the water. Code "Y" flag will not be displayed. Races will likely be run without returning to shore. Bring sufficient water, sunscreen, etc.

Accomodations: Camping with bathhouse on site at no charge. Bring your own toothbrush. Gates open Friday afternoon for early arrivals. Open fires are not permitted at LNYC. NO PETS.
