

## 30<sup>th</sup> Annual Carolina Keelboat One Design Regatta & U20 East Coast Championship Lake Norman Yacht Club November 14-15, 2020

# **NOTICE OF RACE**

The 2020 Carolina Keelboat One Design Regatta is being held with several modifications due to the COVID-19 pandemic. Lake Norman Yacht Club will adhere to the CDC, State of North Carolina, and local guidelines at all times during this event. Please review the "LNYC Coronavirus Phase 3 Reopening Protocol" which can be found on the document page of the regatta website. Safety precautions, such as social distancing, frequent hand washing and the use of a face mask especially when on land, should always be followed. The safety of our members, guests and staff are the driving force for the modifications to this annual event. All participants must sign the "Covid-19 Release Statement" prior to competing in the regatta. Please note there will be **NO** on-site registration, check-in, competitors' meeting or organized dinner. Regatta scoring and protest hearings will be done remotely to ensure safety. Be sure to register online with your correct sail number and email address.

## 1. RULES

- 1.1. This Regatta shall be governed by the rules as defined by the Racing Rules of Sailing, with the following changes:
  - 1.1.1. US Sailing prescriptions to rules 63.2 and 63.4b shall not apply.
  - 1.1.2. Appendix V, Alternative Penalties V1 and V2 will be in effect.

## 2. ELIGIBILITY & ENTRY

- 2.1. The regatta is open to one-design keelboats.
- 2.2. One Design Classes shall consist of not less than three like boats.
- 2.3. Eligible boats may enter the regatta by registering online at www.regattanetwork.com/event/21149

## 3. REGISTRATION FEES

- 3.1. Registration is \$50 per keelboat
- 3.2. Payment must be received by November 7th to avoid a late fee of \$15.
- 3.3. All registrations must be paid on-line.

## 5. SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

Sailing Instructions will be available online at the Regatta Website.

## 6. VENUE

The racing venue will be on Lake Norman.

## 7. COURSES

- 7.1. Courses to be sailed will be windward-leeward around the buoys courses for all classes as described in the sailing instructions.
- 7.2. Classes will be announced on the regatta website "Notices" page after the registration period has expired.

## 8. Penalty System

Appendix V Alternative Penalties, V1 and V2 will be in effect.

## 9. SCORING

- 9.1. Scoring will be Low Point Scoring System Appendix A.
- 9.2. A minimum of one race constitutes a Regatta for all fleets.
- 9.3. When fewer than five races have been completed, a boat's series score will be the total of her race scores. When five or more races have been completed, a boat's series score will be the total of her race scores excluding her worst score.
- 9.4. There is no limit on the number of races

#### 10. AWARDS

Trophies will be awarded based on number of boats registered by November 7, 2020:

# boats in fleet	trophies
3-4	1
5-7	2
8-12	3
13 or more	4

## **11. DISCLAIMER OF LIABILITY**

Competitors participate in the regatta entirely at their own risk (See rule 4, Decision to Race). The organizing authority will not accept any liability for material damage or personal injury or death sustained in conjunction with or prior to, during, or after the regatta

## **12. STORAGE**

Boats wishing to stay at LNYC until the Keelboat Mid-winters (March 2020) must complete the LNYC Boat Storage Waiver prior to leaving LNYC. The waiver can be requested from the Regatta chairman.
