NOTICE OF RACE 7 August 2020

1. **BACKGROUND**

The 2020 Konigshofer Trophy regatta will be sailed in Shields Class One Design yachts in Monterey Bay in honor of Jon Konigshofer, a founding member of Stillwater Yacht Club, and an early member of the Monterey Peninsula Yacht Club. Jon was a lifelong competitive sailor who won championships in the Star, International 110 and Mercury. He campaigned his L-36 "Wildwind" actively on Monterey and San Francisco Bays. An architect by trade, Jon designed the original MPYC clubhouse as well as numerous homes and commercial properties. Well into his eighties, Jon skippered "Stillwater" to second place in the regatta that bears his name. The Konigshofer Trophy was presented to the Stillwater Yacht Club by Robert M. Allan.

2. RULES

The regatta series will be governed by the rules as defined in The Racing Rules of Sailing.

3. **ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRY**

- 3.1 The regatta is open to boats owned by MPYC members of Shields Class boats and will be sailed under One Design Class Requirements
- 3.2 All Shields Class Boats already registered for the MPYC 2020 sailing season, are automatically registered for the regatta.
- 3.3 In accordance with MPYC racing requirements, at least one person on board for each race shall be an active MPYC member during all races to be eligible to race the event.

4. FEES

Entry fees are specified in the MPYC Regatta Network race registration portal.

5. **BOATS**

The Konigshofer Trophy will be competed in the Shields Class yachts following compliance with their published One Design Class rules and safety requirements

6. **SCHEDULE**

- 6.1 Time of First Warning Signal shall be no earlier than 13:00 on the noted race day.
- 6.2 Number of races sailed to equal an event shall be a minimum of one and maximum of three races as determined by the race committee in consultation with the fleet captain or fleet captain's designated on-water representatives.

7. **SAILING INSTRUCTIONS**

- 7.1 The 2020 MPYC Sailing Instructions shall apply. Additional sailing instructions, if required will be posted on the Monterey Peninsula Yacht Club deck no later than by 11:00 am on the day of race.
- 7.2 In accordance with rule 14.3 of the 2020 MPYC Sailing Instructions, all competing boats are strongly encouraged to comply with relevant social distancing guidelines, and to wear face masks in accordance with California and Monterey county guidelines.
- 7.3 On the water communications before and during the race will be made by the Race Committee via Marine VHF radio on Channel 68.

8. **VENUE**

- 8.1 Racing for this event will occur within Monterey Bay.
- 8.2 The starting area will be determined by the Race Committee

9. **COURSES**

The courses are described in the 2019 MPYC Sailing Instructions for One Design Class yachts using inflatable buoys.

10. **SCORING**

Scoring of all MPYC races will be in accordance with the 2020 MPYC Sailing Instructions. One Design scoring will be in effect, i.e. order of finish.

11. PRIZES

Prizes shall be awarded for the Konigshofer Trophy following the event. Prizes for this event shall be independent and separate from that of Rule 18 of the 2020 MPYC Sailing instructions and adjusted as appropriate by the MPYC Race Chair and the Shields Fleet Captain. No trophy presentations will be held.

Competitors voluntarily participate and compete in the noted event and/or regatta entirely at their own risk. The organizing authority will not accept any liability for material damage or personal injury, or death sustained in conjunction with or prior to, during, or after the event and/or regatta.
