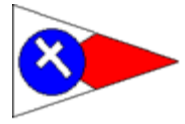
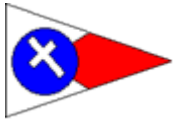

SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

1. Rules

- 1.1 This series will be governed by the rules as defined in the *Racing Rules of Sailing* (RRS.)
- 1.2 The first sentence of RRS 40 is changed so that competitors shall comply with the obligations of RRS 40 (wear a PFD) whether or not the Race Committee displays flag Y with one sound.

2. Notice to Competitors

- 2.1 Notices to Competitors will be posted on-line at https://www.regattanetwork.com/event/21182#_docs
- 2.2 On the water, the Race Committee will use VHF channel 68 for communication.
- 2.3 The race starting in Moss Landing will use VHF 72 for communication.

3. Changes to Sailing Instructions

Any change to these sailing instructions will be posted on line at the link in section 2.1 before 1100 on the day it will take effect, except any change to the schedule of races will be posted by 2000 on the day before it will take effect.

4. Signals Made Ashore

- 4.1 Signals made ashore will be displayed from the SCYC Clubhouse Flagpole.
- 4.2 When flag AP is displayed ashore, "1 minute" is replaced with "not less than 60 minutes" in the RRS Race Signals description of flag AP.

5. Schedule of Races

Dates of racing and number of races for all classes:

Oct 25	1 st warning at 1225	One race starting in Santa Cruz

6. Class Flags

7. Marks

- 7.1 All marks listed in the table below are rounding marks except marks "Start" and "Signal Vessel".
 7.2 Gate1 is comprised of mark "Start" and mark "Signal Vessel".
 7.3 If a mark is missing, the Race Committee will attempt to replace it with an inflatable mark at approximately the same location. This changes RRS 34.

8. Courses

- 8.1 The course to be sailed will be indicated by the displaying a numerals pennant(s) from the signal vessel.
 8.2 A chartlet provided below shows the relative positions of the marks.
 8.3 All marks followed by a "(stb)" in the Mark Rounding Order tables below shall be left to starboard, other marks shall be left to port except marks "Start" and "Signal Vessel".

9. The Start

- 9.1 ML Start will be between mark Moss Landing entrance buoy (“1”) and Moss Landing safe water buoy (“MLA”). RRS 26 is changed for this start so that visual signals will be replaced by sound signals transmitted by VHF on Channel 72. All classes will start together with no display of class flags.
- 9.2 The SC Start will be between mark “Start” and the staff of an orange flag displayed from the signal vessel.
- 9.3 Between the preparatory signal and starting signal, a boat shall have the spinnaker head below the main-boom gooseneck.
- 9.4 The Race Committee may hail, on VHF, the sail number or other identifying feature of any boat that was on the course side of the starting line at her start signal. The failure of a hail, the failure of a boat to hear a hail, or the order of the hail(s) shall not be grounds for a boat to request redress. This changes RRS 62.1.

10. The Finish

- 10.1 The finishing line for courses starting in Moss Landing will be between mark “Government” and the staff of an orange flag displayed from the SE end of the SC Municipal Wharf.
- 10.2 The finishing line for courses starting in Santa Cruz will be between mark “Start” and the staff of an orange flag displayed from the signal vessel.

11. Check out

A boat that retires from a race shall notify the race committee at the first reasonable opportunity.

12. Penalty System

- 12.1 RRS 44.1 is changed so that the Two-Turns Penalty is replaced by the One-Turn Penalty.

13. Protests and Requests for Redress

- 13.1 Protest Forms are available at the SCYC Regatta Shed. Protests and requests for redress or reopening shall be delivered to the Regatta Shed within the time limit.
- 13.2 The protest time limit is sixty minutes after the signal vessel has arrived at her berth in Santa Cruz Harbor. The protest filing time limit will be posted.
- 13.3 Notices will be posted no later than thirty minutes after the protest filing time limit to inform competitors of hearings in which they are parties.
