Rules

The regatta will be governed by the *Rules* as defined in the 2017-2020 Racing Rules of Sailing, the Sailing Instructions and this Notice of Race.

Eligibility

This regatta is open to all boats with valid 2020 PHRF-GB certificates, boats entering for GBCA Club Handicap, and others that can form a one design class and supply a set of class rules, subject to the discretion of the race committee. A minimum of three boats is required to form a class. Classes which have formed by 1700 hours Wednesday, November 18th, 2020 will be awarded trophies as follows:

> 3 boats: 1st place

➤ 4-6 boats: 1st, 2nd place

> 7+ boats: 1st, 2nd, 3rd place etc...

Classes which form after 1700 hours Wednesday, November 18, 2020 are eligible for trophies, but trophies may not be available for presentation at the awards ceremony. Additional prizes may be awarded at the discretion of Race Committee.

Entries

Competitors may enter online at: Registration. The entry fee will be \$40.00. Current GBCA Senior members will receive a \$5.00 discount. Entry fees will be refunded if the entry is withdrawn prior to the entry deadline. The deadline for all entries is Friday, December 4th, 2020 at 1930 CST. However, entries received after 1700 CST, Wednesday, November 18th, 2020 will be subject to a \$10.00 late fee. Late entry fee is waived for this event.

Chili Entries

There will be a separate Chili Competition open to any individual or group. Entrants are requested to provide enough Chili for sampling by 10 judges. Judges will be selected by the GBCA Commodore or her delegate. Prizes will be awarded for the following: The best overall chili and the best chili submitted by a competitor who sailed in the regatta. There is **no** entry fee for the chili competition. Due to CDC regulations, there will be no chili competition with any sharing of food.

Courses

Courses will be distance courses around a combination of fixed government marks and/or dropped tetrahedron marks; located in that part of Galveston Bay bounded by The Bayport Ship Channel, The Houston Ship Channel and the shoreline between Red Bluff and San Leon.

Sailing Instructions

Sailing instructions will be available at the GBCA office after 1900 Friday, December 5th, 2020 and at Sailing Instructions.

Any change to the sailing instructions or to the schedule of races will be posted before 0800 on the day it will take effect.

No races will be excluded from scoring. This Modifies RRS A4. One completed race constitutes a series.
