



NOTICE OF RACE

Date: August 29 & 30, 2020

Venue: This year's event includes a long distance race (cruise) on Saturday with 13 nautical miles of downwind fun from Santa Cruz to Moss Landing and buoy races on Sunday outside the Moss Landing Harbor in wonderful Monterey Bay.

Organizing Authority: Santa Cruz Hobie Beach Fleet 240 and Hobie Division 3

Rules: The Regatta will be governed by the rules as defined in the US Racing Rules of Sailing 2017-2020

Registration & Fees: \$50/boat by August 21 to avoid late fee! \$18 Launch Fee Payable to the Moss Landing Harbor District

Eligibility & Requirements: This event is open to qualified Hobie sailors. Each boat must comply with the following requirements:

1. Racers must wear a Personal Floatation Device
2. Racers must monitor VHF channel 68 and communicate with the Race Committee
3. Racers must carry a whistle
4. Bring on board: marine compass, GPS and suitable charts for piloting (Saturday's race)
5. Bring on board: cell phone with call number listed on the entry form (Saturday's race)
6. Racers must wear appropriate immersion protection (wet or dry suit)

Also recommended: sunscreen, water, food, hat, flares, waterproof bag

Saturday's Race: The morning of the race you will need to prep, launch and tie up your boat at the Santa Cruz Harbor, and shuttle your trailer to

Moss Landing. The drive to Moss Landing typically takes 1/2 an hour and a little longer to return. Unfortunately due to Covid-19, official shuttle transportation will NOT be available. You must arrange for your own transportation.

Competitors' Meeting: Saturday, Noon: on the beach in front of the Crow's Nest in Santa Cruz. All boats must check-in 30 minutes prior to the start time via VHF on Channel 68.

Race start: Saturday 1:00 PM (warning signal at 12:55 PM)

Sunday's Race Schedule: Competitor's meeting 10am @ Elkhorn Yacht Club
Races Start: Noon. No races after 3PM

Awards at the Elkhorn Yacht Club Grass Area on Sunday

Sailing Instructions: Will be posted to Regatta Network

Accommodations: Limited Tent Camping on EYC lawn, \$10
