**NOTICE OF RACE**

**1) RULES**

- a) The regatta will be governed by the rules as defined in *The Racing Rules of Sailing* and including the [DragonFlite 95 Restricted Class Rules](#) (DF95-RCR).
- b) RRS Appendix E will apply.
- c) Any Center for Disease Control (CDC) or State of Texas guidelines in effect with respect to COVID-19 will be strictly followed.

**2) ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRY**

- a) The regatta is open to all DragonFlite 95 boats.
  - b) Eligible competitors may register by completing the online entry form located at: [https://www.regattanetwork.com/clubmgmt/applet\\_registration\\_form.php?regatta\\_id=21189](https://www.regattanetwork.com/clubmgmt/applet_registration_form.php?regatta_id=21189)
  - b) Entry forms and fees are due by Wednesday, September 30th at 1100 hours.
  - c) Late entries may be accepted at the discretion of the Race Committee.
  - d) The following restrictions on the number of boats apply: Forty-five (45). A waiting list will be established, and the Race Committee reserves the right to increase the number of competitors.

**3) FEES**

- a) The entry fee of \$60 is due at the time of registration and includes one Saturday night dinner wristband and two drink tickets.
- b) Additional dinner wristbands may be purchased in the [regatta store](#) for \$25
- c) Box lunches may be purchased in the [regatta store](#) for \$10.

- b) The Inner Harbor will be marked to restrict boat traffic.

## **8) SCORING**

- a) The scoring system is the AMYA Heat Management System (HMS).
- b) The fleet will be divided into heats of no more than 15 boats

## **9) PRIZES**

Prizes will be given to the top ten finishers.

## **10) LIABILITY**

- a) Competitors participate in the regatta entirely at their own risk. See RRS 4, Decision to Race.
- b) By participating in the Regatta, each competitor agrees to use the Lakewood Yacht Club facilities at his or her own risk. To the fullest extent permitted under Texas law, each competitor unconditionally and irrevocably releases and discharges Lakewood Yacht Club, its Officers, Board of Directors, agents, and all other persons who assist in maintaining equipment or in organization and/or conducting races from all claims and legal liability for personal injury, death or property damage incurred in connection with the regatta. The organizing authority, Bay Access Sailing Foundation, will not accept any liability for material damage or personal injury or death sustained in conjunction with or prior to, during, or after the regatta.
