**NOTICE OF RACE & SAILING INSTRUCTIONS**

You are cordially invited to join us for the Coconut Grove Sailing Club's 2020 Annual One Design Regatta. We are expecting entries in the Etchells, J24, Sonar, J70, Snipes, Flying Scot and Laser Classes. Flying Scots will also be sailing for the Sally Russell Trophy and the Charlie Fowler Trophy. Snipes will be sailing for the Gonzalo "Old Man" Diaz Trophy.

**Registration.** The registration fee is \$0 for BBYRA boats and \$40 for other boats. All boats (including BBYRA) must register at [regattanetwork.com/event/21191](http://regattanetwork.com/event/21191) on or before 6pm on Thursday, September 24, 2020. No registrations will be accepted after that date and time. Registering skippers must indicate the names and emails of all crew, and each crew person must complete a short crew registration, agreeing to the regatta waiver of liability.

**Sailing Instructions.** Racing will be governed by the *rules* as defined in *The Racing Rules of Sailing (RRS) 2017-2020*, except as modified and supplemented by the Biscayne Bay Yacht Racing Association Notice of Race and Sailing Instructions 2020-2021, General Conditions and Sailing Instructions, Part II – Sailing Instructions: One Designs (available at [www.bbyra.net](http://www.bbyra.net)). No separate Sailing Instructions will be issued.

Six races are scheduled with no more than four in a day, weather permitting (this changes BBYRA 8.2). Each boat's worst score will be excluded if six races are completed (this changes BBYRA S2.1). Otherwise, all races will be scored. This changes RRS Appendix A2 and BBYRA General Conditions and Sailing Instructions for 2019-20.

Protests shall be delivered electronically to [richard.etkin@gmail.com](mailto:richard.etkin@gmail.com) within 1 hour after the Race Committee Signal Boat docks. A protest email is sufficient (instead of the actual protest form) if it includes the name or sail numbers of the boat protesting and being protested, the incident, where and when the incident occurred, and (if possible) a cell phone number suitable for texting. The protest time limit and a list of protests received will be posted on the official notice board on Regatta Network. Hearings will be held as soon as practicable after racing via Zoom. This changes BBYRA 15.2.

#### **GENERAL INFORMATION APPLICABLE TO ALL ONE DESIGN CLASSES**

- On each race day, each boat must check-in by sailing past the stern of the Race Committee boat on starboard tack prior to the warning signal of the first race in which it will be competing. No check-ins will be accepted during a starting sequence.
- CGSC parking is limited to Members only. Parking is available around the circle (metered) or at the Public Parking Garage next to the Sonesta. Class boats and trailers may be stored in the boat storage areas.
- Two electric hoists are available at CGSC. A public boat ramp is located adjacent to the Club property. One floating dock is available at the Club.
