**NOTICE OF RACE & SAILING INSTRUCTIONS**

You are cordially invited to join us for the Coconut Grove Sailing Club's 2020 "Keel Boat End of Summer Fling". One-design boats are welcome to race in the ARC class.

**Registration.** The registration fee is \$0 for BBYRA Handicap boats and \$20 for all other boats. All boats (including BBYRA) must register at [regattanetwork.com/event/21195](http://regattanetwork.com/event/21195) on or before 6pm on Thursday, October 15, 2020. No registrations will be accepted after that date and time. Registering skippers must indicate the names and emails of all crew, and each crew person must complete a short crew registration, agreeing to the regatta waiver of liability.

**Sailing Instructions.** Racing will be governed by the *rules* as defined in *The Racing Rules of Sailing (RRS) 2017-2020*, except as modified and supplemented by the Biscayne Bay Yacht Racing Association Notice of Race and Sailing Instructions 2020-2021, General Conditions and Sailing Instructions, Part II – Sailing Instructions: Handicap (available at [www.bbyra.net](http://www.bbyra.net)). No separate Sailing Instructions will be issued.

Protests shall be delivered electronically to [richard.etkin@gmail.com](mailto:richard.etkin@gmail.com) within 1 hour after the Race Committee Signal Boat docks. A protest email is sufficient (instead of the actual protest form) if it includes the name or sail numbers of the boat protesting and being protested, the incident, where and when the incident occurred, and (if possible) a cell phone number suitable for texting. The protest time limit and a list of protests received will be posted on the official notice board on Regatta Network. Hearings will be held as soon as practicable after racing via Zoom. This changes BBYRA 15.2.

#### GENERAL INFORMATION APPLICABLE TO ALL CLASSES

- On race day, each yacht must check-in by sailing past the stern of the Race Committee boat on starboard tack prior to the warning signal of the first race in which it will be competing. No check-ins will be accepted during a starting sequence.
- Class Flags for the Handicap Classes will be as follows:
  - ORC Class 1 - Dark Blue & White
  - ORC Class 2 - Orange & White
  - ARC Class 3 -- Dark Green
- CGSC parking is limited to Members only. Parking is available around the circle (metered) or at the Public Parking lots around the Grove.

#### PRIZES

Prizes will be awarded to 1<sup>st</sup>, 2<sup>nd</sup> and 3<sup>rd</sup> place boats in all classes with at least five boats starting. The ARC class may be divided into subcategories at the discretion of the Organizing Authority for the purpose of prize giving. A 1<sup>st</sup> place will be awarded to classes with less than five yachts starting.
