

Coconut Grove Sailing Club 2020 CGSC Keel Boat End of Summer Fling August 29, 2020 NOTICE OF RACE & SAILING INSTRUCTIONS (amended 8/16/20)

You are cordially invited to join us for the Coconut Grove Sailing Club's 2020 "Keel Boat End of Summer Fling".

Registration. The registration fee is \$25. All boats must register at <u>regattanetwork.com/event/21199</u> on or before 6pm on Thursday, August 27, 2020. No registrations will be accepted after that date and time. Registering skippers must indicate the names and emails of all crew, and each crew person must complete a short crew registration, agreeing to the regatta waiver of liability.

Sailing Instructions. Racing will be governed by the *rules* as defined in *The Racing Rules of Sailing* (*RRS*) 2017-2020, except as modified and supplemented by the Biscayne Bay Yacht Racing Association Notice of Race and Sailing Instructions 2019-2020, General Conditions and Sailing Instructions, Part II – Sailing Instructions. Course Card with Lat/Lon of all marks to be used is available at <u>www.bbyra.net</u> home page. No separate Sailing Instructions will be issued.

Protests shall be delivered electronically to <u>richard.etkin@gmail.com</u> within 1 hour after the Race Committee Signal Boat docks. A protest email is sufficient (instead of the actual protest form) if it includes the name or sail numbers of the boat protesting and being protested, the incident, where and when the incident occurred, and (if possible) a cell phone number suitable for texting. The protest time limit and a list of protests received will be posted on the official notice board on Regatta Network. Hearings will be held as soon as practicable after racing via Zoom. This changes BBYRA 15.2.

GENERAL INFORMATION

- Boats will assemble approximately one mile south of the east entrance to Dinner Key Channel
- Signal Boat location N 25° 42.300 W 080° 12.600
- The Race Committee will communicate with boats on VHF channel 69.
- Each yacht must check-in by sailing past the stern of the Race Committee boat on starboard tack prior to the warning signal of the first race in which it will be competing. No check-ins will be accepted during a starting sequence.
- All boats will race in either the Spinnaker (racing, Orange & White class flag) or Non-Spinnaker (cruising, Dark Green class flag) class. Competitors are not required to fly class flags. The boats may be further divided into subcategories at the discretion of the Organizing Authority for the purpose of starting and/or determining winners.
- The regatta will use handicapped Time-on-Distance scoring, based on a boat's ARC rating.
- There are no physical trophies for this regatta. All participants will be informed of the winners by email.
- <u>CGSC parking is limited to Members only</u>. Parking is available around the circle (metered) or at the Public Parking lots around the Grove.
