Open to: PHRF self-righting sailing vessels 19 feet and longer.

The St. Joseph's/Candler Leukemia Cup

Trophies will be awarded to the first three boats in each PHRF and One-Design Fleets. St. Joseph's/Candler Leukemia Cup scoring will be calculated based on 1 day (Saturday) race results and overall fundraising dollars for each boat entered. We will have separate awards for St. Joseph's/Candler Leukemia Cup Scoring as well as overall On the Water Scoring.

The McIntosh Cup

Trophies will be awarded to the first three boats in each PHRF and One-Design Fleets. St. Joseph's/Candler Leukemia Cup scoring will be calculated into the McIntosh Cup based on 2 day (Saturday and Sunday) race results.

The Barbara Ann/Hugh Bear Memorial Youth Trophy

This Trophy honors the late Barbara Ann McIntosh & Hugh Berry for their contributions to junior sailing in Savannah. It is designed to encourage PHRF sailors to invite junior sailors (18 or younger) to participate in big boat sailing.

The Old Pole Award – To be given the Club with the best combined scores in A & B fleets combined.

Classes: A: Spinnaker, B: Non-spinnaker & C: J-24

Last Registration will be available in the Dockhouse, Sat Oct. 10th from 8:00 AM – 9:55 AM.

Guest Club Cards will be available at registration to purchase food and drink at the club.

Entry fee: Entry fee is \$100.00. Includes both the St. Joseph's/Candler Leukemia and McIntosh Cup Regattas.

Registration includes 1 t-shirt, 1 hat, coffee & pastries, awards ceremony and reception on Saturday and Sunday (Beer and heavy hors-d'oeuvres on Saturday with complimentary a Gosling's swag bag, Beer and heavy hors-d'oeuvres on Sunday). Trophies will be awarded Saturday and Sunday afternoon for each event.

Additional shirts and hats can be pre-purchased for crew members.

All money raised for the St. Joseph's/Candler Leukemia Cup must be turned in by race day on October 10th prior to the first warning signal. Fundraising incentive items may be earned based upon the amount of money raised for the Leukemia & Lymphoma Society.

All remaining proceeds will be given to LLS as a donation.

0955 – Registration closes, **1000 – Skipper's meeting**
1200 – Scheduled Warning signal for first class
1730 – After Race reception gathering as noted above

Sunday, October 11^h, 2020 (McIntosh Cup Day 2)
1030 – Warning signal first class; other races to follow (No races to start after 1430)
Awards ceremony will be held in the SYC Main Bar following the conclusion of all races.

Rules: The regatta is governed by the “rules” as defined in the current Racing Rules of Sailing

Please note ... Rule 42.3(i) will be in effect for this Regatta (Please check the SI's).

Ratings: Ratings will be assigned by either US Sailing's most recent PHRF reporting book, or; if convened and determined, the Coastal Clubs Ratings Committee based on local & National averages as adopted for local club racing.

Memorial Youth Trophy – There is no limit to the number of juniors that can be invited. A 1% PHRF rating benefit will be given for each junior crew up to a max of three. (3%)

Donations: The Savannah St. Joseph's/Candler Leukemia Cup Regatta was the first Leukemia Cup in the US to have junior sailors and the 4th largest Leukemia Cup Regatta in the nation. For nearly 31 years, participants have been sailing in communities throughout the country in support of Leukemia & Lymphoma Society through fundraising efforts.
