

## Notice of Race Wickford Regatta 2020

Wickford, RI, USA September 12-13, 2020 Wickford Yacht Club is the Organizing Authority



- **1. Rules:** The regatta will be governed by the Racing Rules of Sailing and the class rules of the invited classes.
- **2. Advertising:** Boats may be required to display advertising chosen and supplied by the organizing authority.
- **3. Venue:** Cold Spring Beach, end of Beach Street, Wickford, RI 02852. The sailing area will be on the West Passage of Narragansett Bay.
- **4. Eligibility and Entry:** The regatta is open to the **505, F-18, 29er, I-420** classes. All entries shall conform to the eligibility rules of the respective classes.

## 5. Event Schedule

<b>Friday</b> 1500-1800	September 11, 2020 Check in and late registration
<b>Saturday</b> 0830-1000 1000 1200	September 12, 2020 Check-in and late registration Competitors meeting Warning signal first race. Subsequent races to follow immediately.
<b>Sunday</b> 1000 1500	<b>September 13, 2020</b> Earliest possible start time. Subsequent races to follow immediately. No races to start after this time.

## 6. Registration and Fees

- **6.1** All registrations must be completed at the event website, <a href="http://WickfordRegatta.com">http://WickfordRegatta.com</a>.
- **6.2** Due to the pandemic and the Registration Requirements required to comply with Covid regulations, fees will be refunded in full for any registrations that fall afoul of the RI State regulations or the competitor's home State regulations post registration.

- **7. Sailing Instructions:** The Sailing Instructions will be available at the event website after September 10, at check in or at the competitor's meeting. The 2019 Sailing Instructions will be available for reference until the 2020 Instructions are posted.
- **8. Courses:** Trapezoid or Windward-Leeward courses will be used for I-420. All other classes will sail Windward-Leeward courses.

- **9. Scoring:** The Low Point Scoring System, Appendix A of the racing rules will apply. There will be one throwout if 4 or more races have been completed. Eight races are scheduled, of which one shall be completed to constitute a series.
- **10. Disclaimer of Liability:** Competitors participate in the regatta entirely at their own risk. See rule 4, Decision to Race. The organizing authority will not accept any liability for material damage or personal injury or death sustained in conjunction with or prior to, during, or after the regatta. Competitors will be required to complete a liability waiver at registration.
