NOTICE OF RACE

1 Rules

- 1.1 The regatta will be governed by the rules as defined in *The Racing Rules of Sailing* (RRS).
- 1.2 Racing Rule 40 is changed as follows: Replace the entire Rule with, "Competitors shall wear personal flotation devices, except briefly while changing or adjusting clothing or personal equipment. This rule applies at all times while afloat. Wet suits and dry suits are not personal flotation devices. Flag Y need not be displayed."
- 1.3 Standard and Radial rigs shall have separate starts and be scored separately.
- 1.4 The organizing authority is the Monterey Peninsula Yacht Club.

2 Eligibility and Entry

- 2.1 Competitors will be required to agree to a waiver of liability as a condition of eligibility. This waiver must be completed either during online registration or at the event check-in.
- 2.2 To compete in the D24 Championships a competitor must be a member of the International Laser Class Association. Competitors who are not members of the ILCA-NA or their national Laser Class Association, may enter by completing registration with the organizing authority www.laser.org.

3 Risk

It is the competitor's decision to enter the regatta and to start or continue any race. The competitors are ultimately responsible for the risks. The competitor will accept full responsibility for all his/her actions during any activity related to the event. This includes on-shore activities before, during, and after the regatta.

8 Courses & Racing Area

- 8.1 Courses will be standard ILCA-NA courses as described in the ILCA-NA Regatta Guidelines.
- 8.2 The racing area will be north of the MPYC yacht club about a mile out to sea.

9 Scoring

- 9.1 The Low Point Scoring System, Appendix A4, will be used except as modified below.
- 9.2 A minimum of 1 race must be completed to constitute a regatta.
- 9.3 When 6 or more races are completed a sailor may discard their worst score.
