6 SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

The sailing instructions will be available before the first race of the series.

7 VENUE

Manasquan River between the Route 35 Bridge and the canal.

8 THE COURSES

Windward/Leeward/Triangular

9 SCORING

9.1 The Low Point scoring system of RRS Appendix A will apply. RRS A.9, Race Scores in a Series Longer than a Regatta, replaces RRS A4.2.

9.2 The number of scheduled races is 12 of which 1 must be completed to constitute the series.

9.3 The Low Point scoring system of RRS Appendix A will apply as changed below. RRS A2 is



changed so one (1) race will be excluded for every four (4) races completed. RRS A9, Race Scores in a Series Longer than a Regatta, replaces RRS A4.2.

9.4 No race shall be declared official unless three or more entrants come to the starting line.

10 BERTHING

Boat Storage is available free of charge, to those intending at least 50% of the races. Skippers intending to store their boat at MRYC during the series should notify MRYC manager at 732-528-6792 in advance of arriving.

11 RADIO COMMUNICATIONS

A boat shall neither make radio transmissions while racing nor receive radio communications not available to all boats. This restriction also applies to mobile telephones.

12 REQUIRED SAFETY EQUIPMENT

- Notes:**
1. Manual bailer must be a minimum of 4-quart capacity.
 2. All boats must carry a towline solely dedicated to towing and/or anchoring and readily available for use at all times. Line must be at least 24' long and of sufficient strength to tow a swamped boat.

13.1 Awards will be presented at the annual MRYC Sailing Awards Dinner in November.

By participating in this event, each competitor agrees to release the race organizers from any and all liability associated with such competitor's participation in this event to the fullest extent permitted by law.

15 INSURANCE

Each participating boat shall be insured with valid third-party liability insurance with a minimum coverage of the policy limit of their homeowner's insurance policy per event or the equivalent thereof.
