Rendezvous: At 1000 in vicinity of Severn River R"2" (Region 3 Annapolis Area Mark "X").

Radio: Boats should monitor VHF 71 for courtesy communications from the Race Committee. Boats

retiring or withdrawing before finishing shall notify the race committee on VHF channel 71 or cell

phone at 240-547-7764 at the first reasonable opportunity. This changes GSI 12.2.

Signals: The first warning signal is anticipated to be at 1100. Starting times, classes, and any additional

class flags used by the Race Committee will be available by Amendment on the notice board

www.shearwatersc.net not later than 1700 on Friday 09 October 2020.

**Course:** Composed of Region 3 Annapolis Area Standard Racing Marks as designated in the 2020

CBYRA Green Book. Course letters will be displayed on race committee starting vessel. It is noted that Region 3 Annapolis Area Standard Racing Marks "B" and "C" have been deleted and replaced with "D" and "G". The course will be designed to be completed in approximately 3 to 4

hours.

Time Limit: Boats not finishing within one hour of the first boat in their class to finish will be scored TLE and

awarded points equal to the number of finishers plus two, but in no case more than the number

of starters. This changes RRS 35 and A4.1.

**Scoring:** Handicap Classes will be scored using Time on Time ratings. Yachts not having a certified

rating will be provided a rating by the Race Committee.

**Protests:** Mail to SSC Race Committee, at address above, postmarked no later than Monday 12 October



2020. Hearing will be held at a time and place to be announced.

Awards: 1<sup>st</sup>/3, 2<sup>nd</sup>/5, 3<sup>rd</sup>/7 & 4<sup>th</sup>/10+ starters. Additional awards may be given at the discretion of the Race

Committee.
