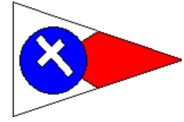

## NOTICE OF RACE

### 2020 JACK AND JILL REGATTA

**SATURDAY, SEPTEMBER 26<sup>TH</sup>, 2020**

#### 1. Rules

- 1.1. The regatta will be governed by the Racing Rules of Sailing (RRS).
- 1.2. The first sentence of RRS 40 is changed so that competitors shall comply with the obligations of RRS 40 (wear a PFD) whether or not the Race Committee displays flag Y with one sound.

#### 2. Notice to Competitors

- 2.1. Notices to Competitors will be posted on-line only.
- 2.2. On the water, the Race Committee may use VHF channel 68 for communication.

#### 3. Eligibility, Divisions, and Entry

- 3.1. Boats holding a valid 2019 Monterey Bay PHRF certificate are eligible to enter this event.
- 3.2. There will be four PHRF divisions as follows: Spinnaker, Non-Spinnaker, Families with children 12 and under, and Families with children 13 and older.
- 3.3. Boats racing shall have exactly two persons on board, one male and one female, except for the family division. Final division assignments will be made at the competitors' meeting.
- 3.4. Eligible boats may only register online at <http://www.scyc.org/racing> before 1035 hours Saturday, September 26, 2020.
- 3.5. The entry fee is \$45.00 if registered by 2000 hours on Wednesday, September 23, 2020. The late entry fee of \$60.00 is applied to all entries received after 2000 hours on Wednesday, September 23, 2020.

#### 4. Schedule

- 4.1. A competitors' meeting will be held at 2000 hours on Friday, September 25, 2020. The meeting will be held by ZOOM. An email with the ZOOM link will be sent to all entrants prior to the meeting.
- 4.2. The scheduled time of the warning signal is 1255 hours.
- 4.3. One race is scheduled. One race will constitute a Regatta.

#### 5. Sailing Instructions

- 5.1 The Sailing Instructions will be posted on-line prior to 2000 hours on Friday, September 25, 2020.

#### 6. Venue

- 6.1 Racing will be around fixed buoys in Monterey Bay. The racing area will be within a 3.5 mile radius of the Santa Cruz Small Craft Harbor west jetty.

#### 7. Courses

- 7.1 Courses will be distributed with the Sailing Instructions.

#### 8. Prizes

- 8.1 Prizes will be given at the discretion of the organizing authority and awarded at SCYC clubhouse following the regatta.
