All races will be governed by the 2017-2020 Racing Rules of Sailing, GYA Regulations for Sanctioned Events, the current prescriptions of U.S. Sailing, One Design Class rules when not in conflict with the forgoing, and FYC Sailing Instructions.

Scoring will be in accordance with RRS Appendix A *except that the number of races completed to allow one (1) throw-out is six (6)*. (This Changes RRS A2). Ties will be resolved in accordance with RRS Appendix A. Multiple races will be attempted, however, one race completed shall constitute a series.
