RULES

1

1.1 The regatta will be governed by the rules as defined in Racing Rules of Sailing.

2 ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRY

- **2.1** The regatta is open to boats of the A-Class Catamaran, Nacra 20, F16, and F18 classes.
- Any sailor who is has recently shown symptoms, is awaiting results, or actively shows symptoms of Covid-19 is not permitted to compete.

3 ENTRY

Registration <u>must</u> be completed on the regatta's webpage (link below). The club will not provide access to a computer, tablet, or smart phone, so it is highly recommended to complete the registration and payment before coming to the event. This is to minimize contact due to Covid-19.

11.1 RRS rules 44.1 and 44.2 are changed so that only one turn, including one tack and one gybe, is required.
