



NOTICE OF RACE The Halfway Race Saturday, October 3, 2020

Organizing Authority: Channel Islands Yacht Club (CIYC) 4100 Harbor Blvd, Oxnard, CA

This race replaces the Channel Islands to Marina del Rey (CI2MdR) Race, which was resurrected for racers and cruising sailors to enjoy the 46nm sail from the Channel Islands area to Marina del Rey as well as the hospitality of the co-sponsoring yacht clubs before and after the race. In light of the ongoing COVID-19 pandemic, closure of yacht clubs to reciprocal visits, and decreasing daylight hours at this time of year, CIYC has decided to shorten the course distance and call this the "Halfway Race." The planned course distance will be approximately 23nm, half the distance of prior CI2MdR races. In the event of light air, shorter course options will be provided.

- 1 **RULES:** The race will be governed by the rules as defined in the *Racing Rules of Sailing*. Area A Random Leg Course (RLC) ratings will be used. Compliance with Safety Equipment Requirements (SERs) for Nearshore Races (https://www.ussailing.org/competition/offshore/safety-information/ser-world-sailing-special-regulations/) is highly recommended.
 - All participants are strongly encouraged to comply with state and local COVID-19 guidelines for social distancing in effect at the time of the race (eg, 6ft between non-household members or mask, buff, or bandana over the nose and mouth when closer than 6ft, handwashing, gloves).
- 2 **RACE CLASSES:** PHRF Spinnaker and Nonspinnaker, Cruiser, and ORCA classes are open to any seaworthy vessel approx 20ft or greater length overall. The Race Committee (RC) may assign a temporary rating for boats without a rating as well as various rating offsets for the Cruiser class.
- 3 **RACE ENTRY & FEES**: Race entry and payment of entry fees (\$30) are available online only, CIYC and/or USSA members' entry fees will be discounted by \$5.

- **PRIZES & HOSPITALITY**: Individual prizes will be awarded after racing. CIYC plans to hold an outdoor post-race awards presentation at CIYC with appropriate precautions against COVID-19. Details will be reviewed during the Virtual Skippers Meeting.
