1. RULES

- 1.1 The series of regattas will be governed by the rules as defined in *The Racing Rules of Sailing*.
- 1.2 The Sailing Instructions will consist of the instructions in RRS Appendix S, Standard Sailing Instructions, and supplementary sailing instructions that will be posted on the official notice board "HYC Race Information" located in the breezeway adjacent to the HYC Office.

2. ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRY

- 2.1 The regatta is open to all HYC members, their families and guests.
- 2.2 The regatta is open to all classes.
- 2.3 A minimum of **two** yachts of the same design will constitute a class.
- 2.4 A class of fewer than the required number of entries will be regarded as having failed to form and may be assigned to another line.
- 2.5 Potential classes may be Windward/Leeward for One Design (**including dinghies**), Pursuit Spinnaker and Pursuit Non-Spinnaker.
- 2.6 **Boats may register at [Regatta Network](#) by October 2.**
- 2.7 Pursuit PHRF Spin/Non-Spin boats must indicate their sail number, handicap, and intended spinnaker or non-spinnaker class.

4. SCHEDULE

- 4.1 **Sunday, ~~21 March~~ 07 June 2020 – HYC Cub Series #1**
~~Competitor's briefing at 1100 hours at the Beachcomber.~~ There will be no racing signals before **1300 hours**. For the W/L Line, the number of races sailed may vary per class and there is no limit to the number of races sailed. The

Pursuit Line will have one race. This Club Series race is one of two in the 2020 HYC Club Series. There will be no awards following this race.

4.2 **Saturday, 3 October 2020 – HYC Club Series #2**

Competitor's briefing at 1100 hours at the Beachcomber. There will be no racing signals before **1300 hours**. For the W/L Line, the number of races sailed may vary per class and there is no limit to the number of races sailed. The Pursuit Line will have one race. This Club Series race is two of two in the 2020 HYC Club Series. **The Awards Ceremony will near the Porthole approximately 1.5 hours after the last race committee boat enters the harbor.**

5. **MEASUREMENT**

- 5.1 Yachts racing PHRF MUST have a current PHRF-GB rating certificate. Yachts without a valid PHRF Certificate will be assigned to the HYC Club Handicap Class.
- 5.2 One Design will comply with all requirements of the relevant class association.

6. **SAILING INSTRUCTIONS**

- 6.1 **The final sailing instructions will be posted online at [Regatta Network](#) by October 2. Please forward your questions to the PRO, Greg Way at Gregory.way@earthlink.net.** The Sailing Instructions will also be posted on the official notice board "HYC Race Information" located in the breezeway adjacent to the HYC Office.

7. **VENUE**

- 7.1 All races will be sailed in the vicinity of the Houston Yacht Club in that part of Galveston Bay bounded by Morgan's Point on the North, the Bayport Ship Channel on the south, the Houston Ship Channel on the East, and the La Porte/Shoreacres shoreline.

8. **THE COURSES**

- 8.1 All fleets will race around designated marks.

9. **SCORING**

- 9.1 A single race is required to be completed to constitute a series.

10. **AFTER-RACE SOCIAL EVENTS**

- 10.1 All competitors are invited to join the Race Committee outside of the Porthole afterwards.

11. **PRIZES**

- 11.1 Trophies will be presented following the HYC Club Series #2 races.
