# NOTICE OF RACE

### 1 RULES

- 1.1 The regatta will be governed by the rules as defined in *The Racing Rules of Sailing*, 2017 2020 (RRS).
- 1.2 All boats shall be in compliance with their respective class rules.

#### 2 ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRY

- 2.1 The regatta is open to Penguin and Comet class boats.
- 2.2 Eligible boats may register by going to the TAYC website (<a href="www.tayc.com/racing">www.tayc.com/racing</a>) and completing the entry form for the event. Entry forms must be received no later than 1600 on Friday, November 6. Online registration is required. Bag lunch requests and payment (\$8 per lunch) must be received with registration.
- 2.3 Races may be cancelled for a class if less than three (3) boats have registered for such class by the registration deadline.
- 2.4 **All regatta participants**, including skipper and crew, **must** individually sign and electronically submit the Covid-19 waiver found at <a href="https://www.tayc.com/racing">www.tayc.com/racing</a> beforehand.

# 3 FEES

3.1 The entry fee is \$20 for CBYRA or USSA members, \$25 for non-members, to be received no later than 1600 Saturday, November 6.

## 4 SCHEDULE

- 4.1 0830-0930 Free coffee, juice and bagels available at the Galley Window.
- 4.2 To ensure that social distancing is maintained, no Competitors' Meetingis scheduled.
- 4.3 1045 Warning gun for first class.
- 4.4 As many races as possible will be sailed, but no race will start after 1430.

### 5 SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

5.1 The Sailing Instructions will be available on the event website no later than one week prior to race day and on race day in the pavilion on the water side of the clubhouse.

## 6 THE VENUE

6.1 Races will be sailed in the Tred Avon River S/SW of the club and N of Foxhole Creek to the west and Bachelor Pt. to the east, the exact location to be determined by PRO. Drop marks will be used.

#### 7 SCORING

- 7.1 A boat's regatta score shall be the total of all her race scores unless five or more races have been completed, in which case her worst score will be excluded, subject to Rule 90.3(b).
- 7.2 At least one race must be completed to constitute a regatta.

#### 8 PRIZES

- 8.1 Prizes will be given as follows: 1 if 3 finishers, 2 if 5 finishers, 3 if 7 or more finishers.
- 8.2 Prizes will be no prize ceremony. Prizes will be mailed to the winners.

## 9 SPECIAL COVID-19 REGATTA RULES

- 9.1 Social distancing as prescribed by the CDC shall be practiced at all times while on Club property.
- 9.2 Masks covering the nose and mouth shall be worn by all individuals while on Club property.
- 9.3 Current state requirements for protection against the transmission of Covid-19 must be practiced throughout the regatta.
- 9.4 The clubhouse will be locked; restrooms may be accessed from the outside only. There will be no food or bar service except pre-ordered lunches and breakfast coffee/juice/bagels will be available at the Galley Window.
- 9.5 Non-crew members will not be allowed on Club property immediately before, during or after the racing with the exception of race officials.

10.1 Competitors participate in the regatta entirely at their own risk. See RRS 4, Decision to Race. The organizing authority will not accept any liability for material damage or personal injury or death sustained in conjunction with or prior to, during, or after the regatta.
