1. RULES

1.1 The event shall be governed by:

1.1.1 ISAF Racing Rules of Sailing(RRS)- Windsurf Competition Rules(WCR).

1.1.6 If there is a conflict between this Notice of Race and the Sailing Instructions, the Sailing instructions will take precedence.

1.1.7 No national authority prescriptions will apply.

2. ELIGIBILITY and ENTRY

2.2 Classes eligible for entry include Formula Foil, IQ Foil, Youth and Junior IQ foil

3. Divisions

3.1 The participating classes and divisions will be: Open Windfoil, IQ foil, U16 Windfoil

4. FEES

4.1 The entry fee for adult competitors is \$90 USD if received by October 24th

4.2 The entry fee for competitors under 25 will be \$75 USD if received by October 24th

4.3 A late fee of \$15 USD will be added for all entries received after October 24th.

4.3 Late registration will be available onsite November 5th from 1600 to 1900.

4.4 Fee includes racing and a t-shirt. Due to Covid 19 no food will be served by the organizing authority.

6. Venue

6.1 Racing will take place in Clearwater Harbor South East of CCSC or in the Gulf of Mexico South of Clearwater pass.

6.2 Competitors will launch from Clearwater Community Sailing Center for racing at either course location.

7. SCORING

7.1 One races are required to be completed to constitute a regatta.

7.2(a) When fewer than 5 races have been completed, a board's series score will be the total of her race scores.

(b) When 5 to 11 races have been completed, a board's series score will be the total of her race scores excluding her worst score.

8. PRIZES

8.1 Awards will be given to 1-3 for each division with over 10 boards pre-registered by 10-24-2020. In divisions with less than ten boards pre-registered by 10-24-2020 only first place will be awarded.

9. DISCLAIMER OF LIABILITY

9.1 Competitors participate in the regatta entirely at their own risk. See rule 4, Decision to Race. The organizing authority will not accept any liability for material damage or personal injury or death sustained in conjunction with or prior to, during or after the regatta.

10. Safety

10.1 Personal buoyancy and helmet is mandatory for competitors under 19.

10.2 Mandatory helmet use is required for all competitors when puffs exceed 15 knots.
