## **NOTICE OF RACE**

### **1 RULES**

- 1.1 The regatta will be governed by:
  - a) The Rules as defined in *The Racing Rules of Sailing*, including Appendix E,
  - b) [DragonForce 65 Restricted Class Rules](#),
- 1.2 All applicable federal, state, and local governmental regulations regarding health, safety and infectious disease control shall be strictly followed by all competitors, coaches, parents, and volunteers, specifically including any crew limits and requirements for personal protective equipment (PPE).
- 1.3 Competitors, coaches, parents, and volunteers using any Chicago Yacht Club facilities, including docks, must follow *House and Ground Rules In Effect Due to Covid-19* (Addendum A).
- 1.4 Violations of Section 1.2 and 1.3 of this Notice of Race shall not be protestable by a competitor but may be protested by the Race Committee or Organizing Authority (OA).

### **2 ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRY**

- 2.1 The series is open to DragonForce 65 remote controlled sailboats only.
  - a) The use of A-Plus rigs is prohibited.
- 2.2 An eligible boat may enter by submitting the online entry form together with the appropriate fee, available at:

- 2.3 All boats must be properly registered online in order to compete.
- 2.4 Registered competitor must be the skipper of his/her boat.

### **3 FEES**

The entry fee is \$20.00 for the series.

### **4 SCHEDULE**

- 4.1 Onsite check-in will take place starting 30 minutes prior to the first start.
- 4.2 The scheduled time of the warning of the first race is 1400 hours.
- 4.3 It is the intention of the Race Committee to run up ten (10) races each day.

## 5 SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

The Sailing Instructions will be available no later than one week before the event and will be posted online.

## 6 RACING AREA

The racing area will be the waters of Belmont Harbor near Chicago Yacht Club - Belmont Station.

## 7 COACHING

- 7.1 Chicago Yacht Club may provide on the water coaching during the racing. This changes rule 41.
- 7.2 A competitor shall not seek redress for failure to receive specific coaching instructions or as the result of the consequences of a particular coaching instruction. This changes rule 62.1(a).

## 8 SCORING

- 8.1 Nine (9) races will constitute a series.
- 8.2 Once a series has been completed, each boat may exclude her worst scores, one (1) race for every five (5) sailed, for the entire series.
- 8.3 The value for a DNC (Did Not Compete) score shall be the number of boats checked-in plus two (2) for that day of racing. ***This changes RRS A9.***

## APPENDIX A



### CHICAGO YACHT CLUB

#### **House and Ground Rules In Effect Due to Covid-19**

1. Reservations are required in advance for any table service at the Club. Walk-ins are not permitted. Similarly, takeout orders must be placed prior to arriving at the Club.
2. Members and their guests must not enter the Club facilities before their reservation time or the time specified for pick-up of their takeout order. No indoor or outdoor waiting area will be provided. Rather, members must wait in their car or boat or in the parking lot, exercising six-foot social distancing from other members and guests.
3. Members and their guests will be permitted to dine for up to 90 minutes from their original reservation time, in order to ensure fair and equitable access to the Club by all members.
4. Members and their guests should check their temperature before leaving home. If a member or any of his or her guests feels ill or under the weather, they should not come to the Club.
5. Members and their guests are subject to having their temperature checked by management at any time they are on Club premises at the sole discretion of management and may be asked to leave the premises if for any reason management believes the member and/or guest imposes any health risk to others.
6. Members and their guests must wear face masks any time they are indoors at the Club, including, but not limited, to walking through the Club to be seated at their table, placing an order, picking up a takeout order or using the restrooms. Members and their guests are strongly encouraged to wear face masks outdoors, while not eating or drinking, for the enhanced safety of others and the Club's employees.
7. Members and their guests must follow all instructions regarding limitations on access to various parts of the Club and the routes to be taken through the Club, including but not limited to, for seating, order placement, pick up of takeout orders and use of the restrooms.
8. Docking will also be by reservation only at both Monroe and Belmont and free docking will be limited to three hours. Both free docking and overnight docking are subject to availability and at the sole discretion of the Dock Master at both facilities. There shall be no gathering on the docks of ten persons or more and face masks must be worn on the docks in those instances six foot social distancing cannot be achieved.
9. Due to limited parking resulting from enhanced outside dining, no guest parking will be available without prior approval from the Manager on Duty. Moreover, valet service can no longer be provided due to health concerns, so members blocking other members in with their vehicle must be prepared to immediately move that vehicle when requested.
10. At all times, members and their guests must comply with any Covid-19 guidelines, rules or regulations issued by the City of Chicago and/or Chicago Park District including but not limited to group sizes on boats and/or docks.
11. As with all other House and Ground Rules, Members will be held responsible for not only their own conduct but also the conduct of their guests. These Rules are designed to address serious health and safety concerns for all individuals on Club premises. Violations will be addressed pursuant to the Club's Bylaws that provide sanctions against members for their own conduct and that of their guests, including among other things suspension of membership privileges and expulsion.
12. These Covid-19 related House and Ground Rules shall remain in full force and effect until further written notice and will be periodically reviewed by the Stations Committee and the Board to determine when appropriate modifications should be made in the future.
