1. RULES

1.1 This series will be governed by the Racing Rules of Sailing (RRS).

1.2 Rule 44.2 is changed: If an incident occurs outside the zone of a rounding or finishing mark, rule 44.2 is changed so that the Two-Turns Penalty is replaced by a One-Turn Penalty.

2. ELIGIBILITY AND CLASSES

2.1 Skipper/Entrant must be a member in good standing of South Coast Corinthian Yacht Club.

2.2 There will be one class. For boats electing to race non spin the Random Leg PHRF rating will be used. Boats without a PHRF certificate will be assigned rating by the Race Committee (RC).

3. ENTRY AND FEES

3.1 The entry fee is \$10.

3.2 Registration should be done on regatta network

5. SKIPPERS MEETING

There will be no skipper's meeting due to COVID-19 health directives.

6. VENUE / COURSE

6.1 The racing area will be on Santa Monica Bay, west of the Marina del Rey Breakwater.

6.2 The course will be emailed to boats registered before 10:00am on race day. It will be similar to the course sailed by Phil Campbell (Security will not chase you out of the area, as they did Phil).

6.3 The approximate course length is 9 miles.

6.4 Spinnakers must be dropped before the end of the detached breakwater is abeam.

6.5 Competitors must sail in the area between the two lines of "No Sail" buoys. The line between any two adjacent "No Sail" buoys is considered a continuing obstruction for the purpose of safety.

7. TIME LIMIT

Boats not finishing by 1700 will be scored as Did Not Finish (DNF). This changes rule 35.

8. PROTESTS

There should be no protests of any significance.

9. COMMUNICATIONS

RC will monitor VHF channel 68.

10. TROPHIES

There will be no trophy awarded after racing due to COVID-19 health guidelines.
