**1 RULES and more rules..**

**This regatta will be sailed in compliance with current Contra Costa County Covid-19 Health Order.** This Order requires that all individuals in Contra Costa County, over the age of 2 years, wear face coverings in accordance with guidance issued by the State of California. Richmond Yacht Club requires all individuals to wear face coverings at all times when on the docks or grounds of Richmond Yacht Club, and requires participants to maintain a 6 foot distance when not on your boat. The owner or skipper of each boat racing is responsible to determine their own social bubble and said bubble is not to exceed 12 people.

**1.1 The Racing Rules of Sailing will govern the races.**

**2. Entry Fee**

Classes and PHRF - \$1.00/foot for Saturday's Pursuit Race. Register online only, and pay by credit card at [www.richmondyc.org](http://www.richmondyc.org) . Registration for Saturday ends on Thursday October 22 at 6PM.

**3. Docking and Parking**

No docking or parking for non RYC members due to Covid restrictions.

**4. Saturday Pursuit race only**

There will be a pursuit race for all classes and boats with current PHRF or BAMA certificates. The course is around Angel and Alcatraz Islands either way. The slowest rated boat will start at 12:00 noon. Monohulls and multihulls will have separate trophies. Pursuit race trophies will be presented on the water as boats finish. Other trophies will be presented as boats finish or depending on condition's during the race.
