 - No onsite registration.
Skippers MUST register and pay online at above link.
 - Registered helmsman should know health of team and ensure no member of team attends with above normal temperature.
 - Masks and social distancing when interacting outside of your immediate team.
 - Boats / teams will be assigned to specific ramp to use throughout regatta.
 - Ice machine is not available.
 - Regatta network virtual notice board (same link as registration) will be official notice board and for protest notifications / documents.
 - Skippers meeting will be held on VHF Channel 69.
 - Teams should participate at their boat.
 - No dinners or party will take place this year. Please make your own arrangements.

Entry Fees:

- (2 days) PHRF / Dinghy / Multihull / Cruiser \$10.00
- Junior Fleet (Sat Only) \$5.00

Racing Details:

Sailing instructions will be posted to the LLSC website prior to the event, and will include the following details:

- Five boats from a one-design class will constitute a fleet with trophies. Separate start is at the discretion of the race committee.
- One race will constitute a regatta for all fleets.
- Auxiliary Fleet Sailing Instructions are in effect for the PHRF Fleet.
- Portsmouth / Multihull Fleet skippers must identify themselves to the Race Committee prior to the warning gun in order to be scored.
- Separate course and start for Cruiser fleet

Cruiser Fleet

To race in the Cruiser fleet, a boat must meet the following qualifications:

- Displacement hull with fixed keel
- Functioning engine, head w/ holding tank, and galley w/ water tank
- Dacron sails, 1 headsail unless cutter-rigged, no spinnaker, no staysail
- PHRF rating certificate* o A temporary certificate may be awarded for this regatta only.

Junior Racing:

This regatta is open to all junior sailors who have yet to reach their 19th birthday. The 2020 Halloween Regatta will also double as the 2020 Jr. Commodore's Cup for LLSC Junior Sailors. This is a club perpetual trophy and will be awarded accordingly by the deed of gift. Racing is Saturday only

- Fleets offered are 420 (trap & spin optional), Laser (full, radial & 4.7) and Opti (RWB & Green)
- 420, lasers & Opti RWB will not have coaches on the water during racing. Support boats are allowed for parents and spectators, but please limit the guidance for the integrity of the Jr Commodore Cup.
- Green fleet will have support boats and coaches providing assistance as needed.
- ● All junior racing will be on a separate course from the main regatta
