## NOTICE OF RACE

### COVID-19 Statement:

LLSC is holding this sailing event with several modifications due to the COVID-19 pandemic. All competitors will follow the CDC and US Sailing recommendations during this event such as social distancing, frequent hand washing and the use of a face covering especially when social distancing cannot be done beyond your boat's crew. By registering for this event, you acknowledge that you and your crew are aware of the potential health risks and will not participate if you have a fever, feel sick or develop symptoms. The kitchen and ice machine are closed. No dinner, party, hayride/ trick or treating, or official social gatherings will take place. Registration will be online only. Regatta Network Notice Board will be the official notice board. Skippers meeting and awards ceremony will be via VHF.

### 1. RULES

- 1.1. The Regatta will be governed by the *rules* as defined in the *Racing Rules of Sailing for 2017-2020*
- 1.2. The prescriptions to RRS 63.2 and 63.4 are deleted.
- 1.3. Appendix V will apply.

### 2. ELIGIBILITY

- 2.1. There will be no onsite registration. All competitors shall register online at Regatta Network Link: [https://www.regattanetwork.com/event/21437#\\_home](https://www.regattanetwork.com/event/21437#_home)
- 2.2. The Regatta is open to all boats (PHRF, One-Design, Portsmouth, Multihulls and Juniors) registered online by October 23, 2020 at 11:59 pm.
- 2.3. The Junior course will have 420, Laser and Opti (Red, White and Blue) plus Green Fleet.
- 2.4. Juniors shall be less than 19 years old.
- 2.5. Five boats from a one-design class will constitute a fleet with separate trophies and may get a separate start.
- 2.6. PHRF boats must have a current Lake Lanier PHRF certificate.
- 2.7. To race in the Cruiser fleet, a boat must meet the following qualifications:
  - 2.7.1. Displacement hull with fixed keel
  - 2.7.2. Functioning engine, head w/ holding tank, and galley w/ water tank
  - 2.7.3. Dacron sails, 1 headsail unless cutter-rigged, no spinnaker, no staysail
  - 2.7.4. Valid Lake Lanier PHRF rating certificate \*Temporary rating **may** be provided.

### 3. FEES

- 3.1. Entry fee for Adults will be \$10.00 per boat for 2 days of sailing.

#### **5. SAILING INSTRUCTIONS**

5.1. The sailing instructions will be posted for each course on Regatta Network by Thursday October 22, 2020 1700.

#### **6. SCORING**

6.1. Low point scoring per Appendix A.  
6.2. One completed race shall constitute a regatta.

#### **7. COACHING, SUPPORT AND SPECTATOR BOATS**

7.1. Juniors in the Green fleet may have support and coaches providing assistance as needed.  
7.2. Coaches, support and spectator boats are allowed, but shall stay clear of the racing area while supporting their sailor(s) so as to not interfere with other races that are occurring.

#### **8. PENALTY SYSTEM**

8.1. Appendix V will apply.

#### **9. PRIZES**

9.1. Prizes will be determined by the number of entrants in each class.

#### **10. HOUSING**

10.1. Housing will be the responsibility of the skipper and crew to stay at local hotels or with friends at LLSC that they are comfortable staying with.
