Notice Of Race

1. RULES

- a. The series will be governed by the rules as defined in *The Racing Rules of Sailing*.

2. ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRY

- a. The series is open to all keelboats with a Lake Ray Hubbard PHRF rating.
- b. There is no fee for entry.

3. SCHEDULE

- a. Sundays, November 2020 thru February 2021
 - i. Series 1: Nov 1, 2020 -> Dec 20, 2020
 - ii. Series 2: Jan 3, 2021 -> Feb 28, 2021

4. SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

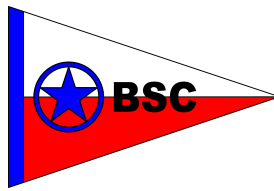
- a. The sailing instructions will be made available prior to the first race, on the Bayside Sailing Club website (<https://www.baysidesailing.club/>)

5. VENUE

- a. The Series will be based out of Sapphire Bay Marina, on Lake Ray Hubbard.
- b. The Racing Area will be Lake Ray Hubbard, south of Interstate 30, east of the Sapphire Bay peninsula.

6. SCORING

- a. The scoring system is Low Point Scoring (Rule A2).
- b. One race is required to be completed to constitute a series.
- c. Throwouts - Starting at 4 Races, add 1 throwout per 4 races.
- d. All participants will be scored in a single PHRF Pursuit Fleet.
- e. Individual race scores will be determined via RaceQs.
 - i. In the event of a failed RaceQs track, participant testimony will be used to supplement.

7. RACE COMMITTEE

- a. There will be *no Race Committee*.

8. SUPPORT BOATS

- a. There will be *no Support Boats*.

9. RACE TRACKING

- a. Participants are **required** to submit a *RaceQs track*, to facilitate scoring in the absence of a Race Committee.

10. RADIO COMMUNICATION

- a. Except in an emergency, a boat that is racing shall not make voice or data transmissions and shall not receive voice or data communication that is not available to all boats.

11. DISCLAIMER OF LIABILITY

- a. **Competitors participate in the regatta entirely at their own risk. See RRS 4, Decision to Race. The organizing authority will not accept any liability for material damage or personal injury or death sustained in conjunction with or prior to, during, or after the regatta.**

12. INSURANCE

- a. Each participating boat shall be insured with valid third-party liability insurance.
