



## Notice of Race

### **A-Class Worlds Training Regatta 1**

***October 19-21, 2020***

**Hosted by: Davis Island Yacht Club (DIYC), 1315 Severn Avenue, Tampa, FL 33606**

#### **1. RULES**

- 1.1 The regatta will be governed by the rules as defined in *The Racing Rules of Sailing*.
- 1.2 The Classic Discipline Trial rules as per IACA website will apply.

**2. ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRY** Current members of the A-Class Catamaran Association are eligible, and may enter by completing entry online at <https://www.regattanetwork.com/event/21442> , and by paying the required fees. There will be an Open Division and a Classic Division.

**3. REGISTRATION AND FEES** The entry fee is \$150. **No entries will be accepted after 1800, Sunday, October 18.** Entry fee includes regatta dinner on Tuesday and hor d'oeuvres on Wednesday. Regatta Bar will be open on Tuesday and Wednesday accepting credit cards. Club is closed on Monday. Limited RV camping is available.

#### **4. SCHEDULE**

The competitors meeting will be on Monday at 0930.  
The first warning signal will be at 1100 on Monday and Tuesday, and 1000 on Wednesday. No warning signal after 1500 Wednesday.

**5. MEASUREMENT** Competitors are responsible for making sure their boat complies with the Class Rules.

**6. SAILING INSTRUCTIONS** The Sailing Instructions will be available on the event website by October 15.

**7. VENUE** The racing area is Hillsborough Bay, in the vicinity of DIYC.

**8. THE COURSES** Windward/leeward courses with offset and gate marks.

**9. PENALTY SYSTEM** Rule 44.1 is changed by substituting the One-Turn Penalty for the Two-Turns Penalty.

#### **10. SCORING**

10.1 When fewer than four races have been completed, a boat's series score will be the total of all scores. When four or more races have been completed, a boat's series score will be the total of its race scores excluding its worst excludable score.

10.2 Nine races are planned of which one race must be completed to constitute a series.

**11. PRIZES** Prizes will be awarded to the first through fifth place teams in each Division.

**12. DISCLAIMER OF LIABILITY** Competitors participate in the regatta entirely at their own risk. See rule 4, Decision to Race. The organizing authority, host club, sponsors and their respective employees, agents or appointees will not accept any liability for material damage or personal injury, illness, disease, or death sustained in conjunction with or prior to, during, or after the regatta.
