AMENDMENT #1 TO THE SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

The following sections of the Sailing Instructions are hereby amended. The changes appear in ***bold italics*** as follows:

6. FLEETS AND CLASSES

- 6.2.1 The Fun Fleet will sail with restricted crew as a result of the Covid-19 virus, crews will be limited to two people who must be full time residents of the same household. The Fun class will sail a medium distance race ***with staggered starts***. On the final day the Fun Class will sail a around the buoys course with a standard rule 26 starting sequence.

7. SCHEDULE

- 7.3 ***The Fun Fleet course will be displayed on the starboard side of the signal boat before the warning for the first start. The RC may make verbal announcements regarding the start sequence.***

8. COURSES

- 8.2** ***Courses*** will be displayed on the starboard side of the signal boat, at or before the class warning. Marks displayed in green are to be left to starboard, those in red to port. A displayed number indicates the corresponding government mark
- 8.3** Inflatable marks for the classes will be large (~ five foot) yellow or orange triangles or cylinders.
- 8.3.1** When numbers "19 or "2" are used, an inflatable offset mark near the corresponding government mark shall be rounded, not the Government mark...

9. START

- 9.2 ***Races will be started as follows:***

9.2.1 ***According to Rule 26 with class flag:***

Spinnaker	Red
Non-Spinnaker	Green

- 9.2.2** ***Rule 26 (with white class flag) will apply only to the first start of the Fun Class. Subsequent starts will be by 2-minute time intervals only. (See Amended Attachment A) The RC may make courtesy announcements.***

- 9.2.3** ***Boats with the same rating will start together.***

10. FINISH

- 10.1** ***The finish line will be the Start line or its continuation on the other side of the Signal Boat. Boats will cross the line in the direction from the previous mark, leaving the Signal Boat to Port.***

11. TIME LIMIT

- 11.1** ***There is no time limit for the Fun Class.***
