SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

Hirams Haul Oct 31 & Nov 1, 2020

Hosted by Indian River Yacht Club

1. Rules

The Regatta will be governed by the current *Racing Rules of Sailing*, the Championship Conditions and the individual competitors' Class Rules, except as any of these are changed by the Sailing Instructions.

2. Eligibility and Entry

Hiram's Haul is open to all single or multi-crew catamarans under 22.5 feet in length with a current US SAILING Portsmouth number.

3. Notices to Competitors

Notices to competitors will be posted on the official notice board, the location of which will be at https:// www.regattanetwork.com/ event/21465# newsroom

4. Signals Made Ashore

Signals made ashore will be displayed prior to the start.

5. Schedule of Races

5.1. Saturday, Oct 31 2020

1000 Skippers Meeting. Lemans Start off the beach. No start earlier that 11 AM.

5.2. Sunday, Nov 1 2020

0930 Skippers meeting No start earlier than 1000.

5.3. The Principal Race Officer is the sole person responsible for determining when races will be started or abandoned. Decisions of the PRO in this regard are not subject to redress. This changes some Class Rules regarding wind strength limits.

6. Racing Area

Pineda POW/MIA Park to Riverside Park***, one mile South of the Capt Hiram's sign in the river.

7. The Start

- 7.1. The class flags will be described at the skippers meeting.
- 7.2. The starting line will be on the beach. Boats will position themselves with the nose of each boat even with each other.

8. The Finish

The finish will be when you are within 20 feet of the landing site at Riverside Park, City of Sebastian.

9. Retirement

Any boat that retires from a race is asked to notify race committee at their earliest convenience.

10. Protests

This is a fun race, and no protests are expected.

11. Penalty System

Rule 44.2 is changed so that the two-turn penalty is replaced by one turn consisting of one tack and one gype.
