

- A. The Grapevine Sailing Club (GSC) is pleased to announce the 2020 Winter Regatta and Toy Drive benefitting the families of soldiers serving at Fort Sill U.S Army Training Center. All races will be governed by the 2017-2020 World Sailing Racing Rules of Sailing (RRS) and the 2020 Winter Regatta Sailing Instructions (SIs). This event will consist of up to four (4) races. One race may constitute a regatta. Liability insurance is required for each participating boat.
- B. Schedule of Events:

0800 ----- On-site late registration opens

0900 ----- Registration closes

0915 ----- Skipper's Meeting

1100 ----- First Signal for race one (1). Additional races to follow.

1730 ----- Refreshments following last race (time is approximate)

1800 ----- Awards (time is approximate)

- C. Eligibility: This is an open event to all sailors, GSC members and non-members alike.
- D. Fleets and Handicaps: Four (4) or more similar boats constitute a one design fleet. Only PHRF handicapping will be used. The Regatta Chairman is the ultimate authority on how boats will be fleeted.
- E. Protests: Protest hearings will be held at Scott's Landing Marina. Protests will be handled according to the procedures outlined in the Sailing Instructions. You must advise the race committee of your intent to protest before leaving the racecourse or your protest will not be heard.
- F. Entry Fee: One unwrapped toy per skipper and crewmember of each participating boat.
- G. We will be adhering to social distancing guidelines. Refreshments will be provided at the toy drop off point, outside the clubroom. Please be respectful of COVID-19 Guidelines and non-sailors in the area. Awards ceremony will be at the Middle Finger Yacht Club (middle finger) unless otherwise directed.
