

# TYCC Wednesday Night Portsmouth Series NOR

#### 1 RULES

1.1 The regatta will be governed by the rules as defined in *The Racing Rules of Sailing* and the *Portsmouth Yardstick*.

#### 2 ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRY

- 2.1 The regatta is open to all centreboard classes and keel boats 19 feet and under that have registered. The entry fee is \$5.
- 2.2 Eligible boats may register online at https://www.regattanetwork.com/event/21506
- 2.3 The Race Committee may add one design classes at its discretion, pending participation.
- 3 SCHEDULE
- Racing will be held each Wednesday during daylight saving time. Two races are scheduled each Wednesday. There will be a rest week after each series.
- 3.2 There will be a competitor meeting on March 10<sup>th</sup>.

#### 5 SAILING AREA

**5.1** Attachment A shows the location of the racing areas.

#### 6 THE COURSES

The diagrams in Attachment B show the courses, including the approximate angles between legs, the order in which marks are to be passed, and the side on which each mark is to be left. The approximate course length will be 25 minutes.

#### 7 SCORING

- 7.1 Each boat's finishing place shall be determined using the Portsmouth Yardstick
- 7.2 The Series will use the low points scoring system.
- 7.3 1 race is required to be completed to constitute a series.
- 7.4 (a) When fewer than 7 races have been completed, a boat's series score will be the total of her race scores.

- (b) When 7 or more races have been completed, a boat's series score will be the total of her race scores excluding worst score.
- 7.5 Competitors undertaking race committee duties may claim average points for 1 race per series.

#### 8 PRIZES

Prizes shall be awarded at the discretion of the Race Committee.


#### 9 DISCLAIMER OF LIABILITY


