Notice of Race and Sailing Instructions

A fun and easy race for **DRYC members**.
Racing and Cruising Class boats are invited to race.

1 RULES

- 1.1** This race shall be governed by the *rules* as defined in the Racing Rules of Sailing (RRS).
- 1.2** All double handed entries SHALL BE CREWED BY PEOPLE THAT CURRENTLY LIVE UNDER THE SAME ROOF. Two additional family members who comply with this rule, may be on board during the race.
- 1.3** From the warning signal, until the boat finishes, 2 of the 4 crewmembers shall sit in the companionway area, may not hike, handle lines or give tactical input. Any boat/crew not complying will be disqualified from the race
- 1.4** For the purposes of safety, auto pilot and self-steering systems may be used (this changes RRS 52).
- 1.5** Spinnakers are not allowed inside Marina del Rey harbor. The head of any spinnaker must be below the lowest spreader, when the bow crosses an extension of the detached breakwater.
- 1.6** Any change to these Sailing Instructions will be posted by 0900 race day at www.dryc.org
- 1.7** Oral instructions may be given on the water by the Race Committee (RC), before the first warning signal.

2 ENTRY & RATINGS

THIS IS A DRYC MEMEBR ONLY RACE. There is no entry fee. The entry deadline is 1700 the day before the race. Enter at www.dryc.org under the racing tab.

- 2.1** Ratings will be based on PHRF of So. Cal. 2020 W/L ratings. PHRF membership is not required.

3 CLASSES, CLASS FLAGS AND SCHEDULE

- 3.1** Divisions will be established for PHRF and Cruising. There will be spinnaker and non-spinnaker classes (non-spin entries include your offset in your rating at entry). If the RC finds an entry unsuitable for the Cruising division, it may be moved into the PHRF division.
- 3.3** Class splits, flags and the order of starts will be posted no later than 0900 race day at www.dryc.org .
- 3.4** The scheduled time of the warning signal for the first start is 1155 (multiple sound signals will be made 1 minute before).

4 COURSE AND MARKS

From the starting line:

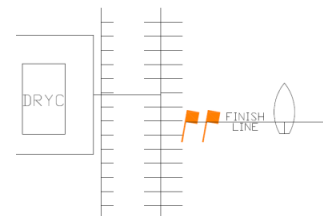
Sail the course signaled by the RC (see Attachment A).

5 THE START

The starting line will be between SS mark and an orange flag on the RC boat (see MDR Course Chart 17).

6 THE FINISH

6.1 The Finishing Line begins at an orange flag on a boat in DRYC's main channel dock and continues through an orange flag in the water (leave both orange flags to port). When your helm position crosses the finishing line, record your finish time. For the purpose of safety, this modifies the definition of *finish*



6.2 All boats shall submit a completed Finish/Retirement form (Attachment B). The form shall be texted or emailed to the Sail Committee Chairman (see NOR/SI 11) within 30 minutes of finishing. **Boats failing to comply will be scored Did Not Finish (DNF)** without a hearing. This changes RRS 35, A4 and A5.

6.3 Boats not finishing by 1700 will be scored DNF without a hearing. This changes RRS 35, A 4.2, and A5.

7 PROTESTS

7.1 Any boat intending to protest shall indicate this on their Finish/Retirement Form (Attachment B) and submit it to the Sail Committee Chairman (in compliance with SI 6.2).

7.2 Protests forms shall be emailed to the Sail Committee Chairman by noon the day after the race (Protest Time Limit). Any Protest hearings will be held via Zoom at a later date.

8 SCORING

See Attachment A for course length.

9 HOSPITALITY/AWARDS

There will be no pre-race gathering at the clubhouse. Starting at 5pm, **there will be a post-race hosted turkey dinner for racers** served on the Aft Deck (which will be tented and heated).

SOCIAL DISTANCING MUST BE FOLLOWED! PLEASE ADHERE TO THE COUNTY AND CLUB GUIDELINES! There will be awards for all entrants.

2020 Del Rey Yacht Club Course Chart

(Please see Marina del Rey Course Chart 17 for mark information)

Course A Handicap distance 10 NM

1. Leave DD Mark to Port
2. Leave 2ES to Port
3. Proceed to **ALL COURSES** below

Course C Handicap distance 7.9 NM

1. Leave D Mark to Port
2. Leave S Mark to Port
3. Leave D Mark to Port
4. Proceed to **ALL COURSES** below

Course B Handicap distance 9.3 NM

1. Leave D Mark to Port
2. Leave 2ES to Port
3. Proceed to **ALL COURSES** below

Course D Handicap distance 5.9 NM

1. Leave D Mark to Port
2. Proceed to **ALL COURSES** below

ALL COURSES

1. Enter the MDR Harbor South Entrance. The "No Sail" buoys on the north side of the entrance channel shall be considered a continuous obstruction (do not cross this imaginary line). Center channel markers in the main channel are not marks of the course.
2. Continue to the finishing line (see NOR/SI #6).
