AWARDS from NAUTI SANTA

<u>Trophies will be awarded for each boat</u>, as follows: The skippers will be numbered in reverse order of finish. For example, if we have 10 boats, the tenth place finisher based on corrected time will be Skipper #1, ninth place finisher will be Skipper #2, and so on. Non-Spinnaker boats will be interleaved into the Spinnaker fleet based on corrected time. If the skipper is not present, a crew member from the boat may represent the skipper.

- Skipper #1 picks an award and opens it, shows it around, models it, reads it, demos it, etc.
- Skipper #2 is next and can either select another unchosen award or take the award #1 had chosen.
- If #2 takes #1's award, #1 must select another unchosen or unopened award.
- Next, it is #3's turn. #3 has two choices. #3 could select a new unchosen award, or take an already chosen award (#1's award or #2's award).
- Then, if #3 were to select #2's award, #2 has two choices. #2 could select another unchosen award or select #1's award. However, an award cannot bounce back and forth between two players without someone else taking possession of the award in between. So, #2 cannot select #3's award because it was just previously taken from #2.
- Prizes are retired after being stolen twice.
