Notice of Race (NoR)

Revised January 19, 2021

1. RULES

1.1 The event is governed by the rules as defined in *The Racing Rules of Sailing*.

2. SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

- **2.1** The sailing instructions will be available after 1700h on February 26, 2021 at Sarasota Sailing Squadron.
- **2.2** The sailing instructions will consist of the instructions in RRS Appendix S, Standard Sailing Instructions, and supplementary sailing instructions that will be on the official notice board located beside the race office.

3 COMMUNICATION

- **3.1** The official online notice board is located at http://www.regattanetwork.com.
- **3.2** VHF radio (channel 72 or other as announced) will be the primary means used by the Race Committee (RC) for the Competitors' Meeting, and in general with the fleet, about activity onshore (carry a radio with you while ashore) and on the water regarding delays, recalls, weather issues.
- **3.3** Following the display of the Individual Recall Flag, the RC will attempt to announce by VHF radio the sail numbers of all boats identified as OCS. Such announcement is a courtesy and failure of the RC to make the announcement or of competitors to hear or understand shall not constitute a ground for redress. This changes RRS 62.1(a).
- **3.4.** [DP] While racing, except in an emergency, a boat shall not make voice or data transmissions and shall not receive voice or data communication that is not available to all boats.

4 ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRY

- **4.1** The event is open to boats of the Melges 15 class.
- **4.2** Boats may only enter the event by registering online at Regatta Network "calendar" at http://www.regattanetwork.com. Registration closes Monday, February 15, 2021.
- **4.3** To be considered an entry in the event, a boat shall complete all registration requirements and pay all fees.
- **4.4** Registration may be limited to 25 boats and 50 people.

5 FEES

- **5.1.** The registration fee is \$125, including Saturday evening box dinner for two, M15 shirts for two (compliments of Melges for those who have not received a shirt from event 1), SSS hats for two (for those who have not received hats from event 1), and post-race beverages.
- **5.2** Additional box dinners may be purchased during registration period (by February 15) for \$20. Additional shirts will not be available beyond those included with registration.
- **5.3** Refunds due to regatta cancellation related to COVID-19, withdrawal from the regatta or other causes will not include non-refundable expenses paid by the event.

6.2 Dates of racing:

Saturday, February 27, 2021	1030 hrs
Sunday, February 28, 2021	1000 hrs

- **6.3** A maximum of 6 races are scheduled but more may be sailed at the discretion of the race officer.
- **6.4** On the last scheduled day of racing, no warning signal will be made after 1400 hrs.

7 VENUE

7.1 Racing will be in Sarasota Bay.

8 COURSES

8.1 Courses to be sailed will be windward/leeward.

9 SCORING

- **9.1** One race is required to be completed to constitute a series.
- **9.2** (a) When fewer than six races have been completed, a boat's series score will be the total of her race scores.
 - (b) When six or more races have been completed, a boat's series score will be the total of her race scores excluding her worst score.

10 RISK STATEMENT

- 10.1 RRS 3 states: 'The responsibility for a boat's decision to participate in a race or to continue to race is hers alone.' By participating in this event each competitor agrees and acknowledges that sailing is a potentially dangerous activity with inherent risks. These risks include strong winds and rough seas, sudden changes in weather, failure of equipment, boat handling errors, poor seamanship by other boats, loss of balance on an unstable platform and fatigue resulting in increased risk of injury. Inherent in the sport of sailing is the risk of permanent, catastrophic injury or death by drowning, trauma, hypothermia or other causes.
- **10.2** Competitors voluntarily assume the risks associated with communicable diseases including but not limited to COVID-19.

11 INSURANCE

11.1 Each participating boat shall be insured with valid third-party liability insurance.

12 PRIZES

- **12.1** Prizes will be awarded to the first three boats; Top Woman (provided 2 or more are registered); top Master (age 50 to 59 years); Top Grand Master (ages 60 to 69), and Top Mega Master (age 70 and above). Award age requirements are determined on the day of the first race of Event 1.
- **12.2** Scoring for the top three all-inclusive Winter Series competitors will be by accumulation of points from all three events.

PRACTICAL INFORMATION (NOT PART OF THE NOTICE OF RACE)

1. COVID-19 RESTRICTIONS AND PRACTICES

- 1.1 No on-site registration will be accepted.
- 1.2 Social distancing is mandatory. Masks are required while on the docks, in clubhouse or other covered areas where social distancing is not possible.
- 1.3 All participants should have the ability to 'self-shelter' (i.e. cars, RVs, etc.) on premises in the event of inclement weather. Additional shelter will be provided but may be insufficient for conditions.
- 1.4 No spectator boat(s) can be provided.
- 1.5 Rules may be added, removed or changed based on local conditions and requirements. Please check often for amendments to the NoR.
- 1.6 All event participants must complete the COVID-19 questionnaire. Event participants' temperatures will be taken daily, prior to entering the SSS grounds. Any participant with an abnormal temperature will not be allowed entry to SSS. This measure is to keep SSS and event participants safe.
- 1.7 Sarasota Sailing Squadron reserves the right to require departure fr0m the grounds of anyone who fails to pass the grounds entry screening or who displays COVID symptoms while on the grounds.

2. Parking

The Sarasota Sailing Squadron is a very active sailing club. Parking is available for trailers and cars outside of the main entrance. Any cars/trailers parked inside the club blocking a member's boat/trailer will be towed at the owner's expense.

3. Accommodations

Due to the COVID pandemic, there is no tent, car or RV camping permitted this year. There are numerous convenient lodging and dining options in the vicinity of the Squadron. Check your favorite lodging web sites, such as www.visitsarasota.com.

4. Food

Due to COVID-19 restrictions and policies, morning coffee will be available at the bar. **There will be no breakfast and no lunch provided**.

Box dinners and drinks will be distributed in a socially distanced manner. COVID rules may require box dinners to be carried away.

5. Water Bottles

Please bring refillable water bottles. Outdoor water refilling station located by the main entrance to the Sarasota Sailing Squadron.

6. Boat Charters

7. Boat Storage

SSS will provide STORAGE FOR BOATS at \$75 per month for January, February and March. BOX TRAIL-ERS MAY BE STORED on the grounds for \$150 per month. Boats left outside of multi-boat trailers must be charged storage at the individual boat rate. Boats and trailers must be removed from the grounds by the end of the day March 31. All vehicles stored on the grounds are subject to being moved as may be necessary to accommodate normal use of the grounds for sailing and parking activities. Storage may be arranged though the http://www.regattanetwork.com in association with registration.

8. Local Racing

Sailors are encouraged to visit SSS for local fleet sailing Wednesdays, Fridays, and some Saturdays in conjunction with the local Flying Scot fleet (see SSS calendar at www.SarasotaSailingSquadron.org), with a separate M15 start for a fleet of three or more – let us know you're coming for a visit! We will need 24 hours notice to bring boats from storage.
