COVID-19 RESTRICTIONS AND PRACTICES

1. HEALTH SCREENING OF PARTICIPANTS ENTERING THE SQUADRON IS REQUIRED.

ALL PARTICIPANTS AND AFTERGUARD MUST COMPLETE THE COVID-19 QUESTIONNAIRE AND SUBMIT TO TEMPERATURE CHECK EACH DAY UPON ENTERING THE GROUNDS.

2. NO ONSITE REGISTRATION WILL BE ACCEPTED. ANY REGISTRATION (INCLUDING PAYMENT(S)) MUST BE COMPLETED BY THE DATE SPECIFIED IN THE ORIGINAL NOR.

3. SOCIAL DISTANCING IS MANDATORY.

MASKS, OVER MOUTH AND NOSE, ARE REQUIRED AT ALL TIMES WHILE COMPETITORS ARE ON SQUADRON PROPERTY, REGARDLESS OF THE ACTIVITY THE COMPETITOR IS ENGAGED, INCLUDING OUTSIDE ACTIVITIES.

ALL PARTICIPANTS SHALL COMPLY WITH USUAL AND WITH POSTED SANITIZING AND SOCIAL DISTANCING PRACTICES.

4. ALL PARTICIPANTS SHOULD HAVE THE ABILITY TO "SELF-SHELTER" (i.e. Cars, RVs, etc.) ON-PREMISES IN THE EVENT OF INCLEMENT WEATHER. ADDITIONAL SHELTER WILL BE PROVIDED BUT MAY BE INSUFFICIENT FOR CONDITIONS.

5. NO SPECTATOR BOAT(S) CAN BE PROVIDED.

6. METHOD FOR NOTIFICATION OF CHANGES TO SAILING INSTRUCTION WILL BE PROVIDED IN THE SAILING INSTRUCTIONS.

7. RULES MAY BE ADDED, REMOVED, OR CHANGED BASED ON LOCAL CONDITIONS AND REQUIREMENTS. PLEASE CHECK OFTEN FOR AMENDED NOR.

8. SARASOTA SAILING SQUADRON RESERVES THE RIGHT TO REQUIRE DEPARTURE FROM THE GROUNDS OF ANYONE WHO FAILS TO PASS THE GROUNDS ENTRY SCREENING, WHO DISPLAYS SYMPTOMS WHILE ON THE GROUNDS, OR REFUSES TO WEAR A FACE COVERING AS DESCRIBED ABOVE.
