On behalf of Davis Island Yacht Club, welcome to the 2021 Sunfish Masters and Midwinters Championship regattas. In an effort to make sure you have a great time and to cut down on confusion we want to go over some important logistics information. Please read carefully. A labeled map has been included with these instructions as a reference for you to familiarize yourself with Davis Island Yacht Club and surrounding area. There will be a gate attendant and several volunteers on hand to guide you through boat drop off/auto and trailer parking.

Gate/Club Hours:

- Gate is open 7:30 am 4:30 pm Tuesday Sunday.
- Gate is opens at 6:30 am and closes at 10:30 am on Mondays. Many members have a remote to open it during closed hours.

Food/Beverage:

- Please be advised there are no organized refreshments or food following the races.
- Club is closed on Mondays; therefore, food and beverage services are not available. Please plan accordingly.
- Tuesday Sunday: There will be food and beverage service available. Non-members will be able to
 purchase from the upstairs concession window but will not be allowed in the club or to use the upstairs
 porch. Credit cards <u>only</u> can be used for purchases.
- Personal food and beverage cannot be consumed or brought within the pool area or under the club, however, you can have personal food and beverage on the launch area.

Bathrooms:

• Important to note that we are undergoing renovation of our pool side bathrooms and they will not be available. We have portable units with showers on the launch area.

Early boat and trailer drop off is Thursday (3/4) and Friday (3/5) from 2 pm-6 pm.

- Volunteers will be present to provide guidance for parking trailers, and Dolly/boat storage.
- There is no parking of cars or trailers on the launch area for the entire regatta, only boats/dollies.
- Proceed to the launch area and unload boat and dolly. Due to the launch area being used Saturday for large high school regatta, boats need to be consolidated in specific areas. Volunteers will indicate where to store your boat.
- Trailers need to be moved to designated parking area as directed by volunteer
- Nonmembers must adhere to the designated parking spaces outside the gate.
- Colored identifying tags will be issued and need to be placed on trailers and dollies. The information to be placed on the tags are: Your Name, Phone Number, and Sail Number.
- If you are sailing only the Masters please place a RED tag on your trailer and dolly. If you are sailing both Masters and Midwinters please place a GREEN tag on your trailer and dolly.

Arrivals and Check-ins: Masters is Sunday (3/7), Team Racing and Midwinters Thursday (3/11)

- Volunteers will be present to guide you and answer questions.
- Park trailer as directed by volunteer and move your car to parking area outside the gate.
- Take boat, dolly and all equipment possible with you to the launch area.
- We will have golf carts to shuttle you to the launch area from parking areas.

Check-in

- Check-in is located under the club house: Masters (3/7), 11 am-4 pm, Team Racing 3/11, 9 am 9:30 am and Midwinters March 11th, 11 am-4 pm
- Please wear masks and maintain your social distance.
- Verify phone number and sail number at check-in.
- Obtain trailer and dolly tags and label with Name, Phone Number and Sail Number.
- RED tags if you are only sailing the Masters. GREEN tags if you are sailing Masters and Midwinters.
- Regatta favors and additional pre-ordered items from Coral Reef may be picked up at this time if you completed your online order in the required time frame.

Masters - Monday (3/8), Tuesday (3/9) and Wednesday (3/10), Team Racing - Thursday (3/11), Midwinters - Friday (3/12), Saturday (3/13) and Sunday (3/14)

- Park outside the gate. No parking for nonmembers within the gate. Plan accordingly for a lengthy walk.
- 8-9am Breakfast power bars will be available beneath club house for competitors.
- Lunch orders may also be picked up at this time.
- Optional competitors lunch order information will be forth coming in separate message.
- Please bring sufficient fluids for hydration.
- Personal items can be placed in designated spot beneath club house while you are out on the water. However, the items will not be locked up or guarded. They are stowed at your own risk.
- Wednesday (3/11) and Sunday (3/14) process for departure will require you to walk your boat/dolly to your trailer for loading.
