



NOTICE OF RACE 2021 WINTER DISTANCE RACES

January 23 and February 27, 2021

Lake Norman Yacht Club

1. RULES

- 1.1. The Series will be governed by the *rules* as defined in *The Racing Rules of Sailing*
- 1.2. The US Sailing Prescriptions of Appendix V (Alternative Procedures for Dispute Resolution) will be in effect.
- 1.3. RRS A2.1 is modified so that no race scores will be excluded.
- 1.4. Competitors are reminded that they must follow local, state, and federal guidance on safety related to COVID-19.

2. ELIGIBILITY

- 2.1. Entrants may register for one of two classes: Spinnaker or Non-Spinnaker. The Classes may be further divided into Divisions or combined based on number of boats registered.
- 2.2. Entrants must have a valid PHRF rating.

3. ENTRY

- 3.1. Eligible boats may enter by completing the online registration form at www.regattanetwork.com/event/21640
- 3.2. Payment must be made online.
- 3.3. Entry is not complete until payment is received.

4. FEES: Entry Fee: \$20.00 per skipper

5. SCHEDULE

- 5.1. One race is scheduled on each race date.
- 5.2. Warning at 1030 AM

6. SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

- 6.1. Will be published online at www.regattanetwork.com/event/21640 at least a week prior to the first race.

7. RACING AREA

- 7.1. The racing area will be the LNKC fixed marks with the starting area in the vicinity of Lake Norman Yacht Club.

8. THE COURSES

- 8.1. Courses will use the LNKC Lakewide Sailing Instructions fixed marks.
- 8.2. It is intended to set a course between 10-16 miles.

9. THE START

- 9.1. There will be a single start that will include both Spinnaker and Non-Spinnaker fleets.

10. SCORING

- 10.1. Boats will be scored using the Time on Time.
- 10.2. Each race will be independently scored, including prizes for each race.

11. PRIZES

- 11.1. Something will be handed out or mailed.

12. ADDITIONAL INFORMATION

- 12.1. There will be no competitors meeting. Please direct questions to Tim Porter (porter.timothym@gmail.com 571-432-7152 or BJ Jones kjonesbj151@gmail.com).
- 12.2. Race Committee will monitor and communicate with competitors on VHF channel 71. Due to the distance the Race Committee may not be in range for VHF communication.
- 12.3. There will only be one Race Committee boat so please use your best judgement when deciding to race in inclement weather or high wind.
- 12.4. In the event of a cancellation, registrants will be notified by email and/or text.
